Chris Hines, CISD Associate Superintendent, provided an update on Steroid Testing. Ninety Conroe High School students were randomly chosen and tested on May 7, 2008. The school did a great job and there were no complaints from parents.

Sheryl Hime reported that all Fitnessgram testing should be completed by May 9, 2008. The results will be submitted to TEA by May 31, 2008.

Victoria Constance, Executive Director of Children's Safe Harbor, provided information on the new "It's Not Just Jenna" curriculum being used in Denton, Texas. She provided information about the Multidisciplinary Conference in August at the Lone Star Convention Center.

Sheryl Hime reported on the Parenting and Paternity Awareness (p.a.p.a.) curriculum from the Texas Attorney General's Office. The Student Health Council created a statement in response to the p.a.p.a. curriculum:

- The SHAC has concerns about the age appropriateness of the curriculum.
- The SHAC feels the tone of the message is not abstinence based.
- The SHAC feels the material should be incorporated into the current CISD Health Curriculum and not be used as a free standing curriculum.
