October 23, 2008

The Chair, Sheryl Hime, called the meeting to order at 4:05pm.

Ms. Hime asked for approval of the SHAC minutes from the May 8, 2008 meeting. Chris McCord made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Faith Casperson seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Ronnie Peacock, CISD Athletic Director, provided an update on Steroid Testing. Sixty-five Caney Creek High School students were randomly chosen and tested the week of October 14th-17th, 2008. All CISD students are required to have a signed steroid testing parent permission slip on file with their schools. Mr. Peacock reported the State of Texas will try to test 50% of all high schools this year.

Mr. Peacock also provided results from the Fitnessgram testing completed during the 2007-2008 school year. He shared the state results as well as CISD results for individual tests. CISD is still waiting on a report with the numbers of students who passed all six tests.

Sheryl Hime presented information on how the Parenting and Paternity Awareness (p.a.p.a.) curriculum has been incorporated into the CISD Health Curriculum. All CISD health teachers received training on the p.a.p.a. curriculum by a representative of the State's Attorney General's Office in August. Training will be provided on October 29th for all CISD health teachers on the health curriculum updates.

Dr. Chris Hines, CISD Associate Superintendent, provided information on the Texas Fitness Grant. Washington Junior High and Travis Intermediate will once again participate in the grant. The CISD School Board approved the application for the grant from the State of Texas.

Dr. Hines also provided an update on the vending contracts for the 2008-2009 school year. He explained that very few carbonated drinks are allowed to be sold on campuses this year and they are limited to diet drinks.

Sherry Sunderman, CISD Director of Guidance and Counseling, provided information on the Dating Violence Teen Symposium on October 25, 2008 presented by The Women's Center.
