REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Students will preregister for summer school from **April 24 – June 2**. Evening registration will be held **on June 5 from 5:00 pm-7:00 pm**.

No registrations will be taken on June 6.

Registration Procedures at each Campus:

Step 1: See the counselor for guidance in course selection. The counselor will create a registration form for the student.

Step 2: See the Tracks person on the campus. This person will take payment for courses, and once payment is received, they will enter the student's courses for summer school.

First Day of Summer School Registration:

June 7 – Students may register on this day. **If a student registers on June 7, he/she is counted absent for the first day and a late registration fee of \$25.00 will be charged.**

No registrations will be taken after June 7.

Payment Options:

In the event a check written to any Conroe ISD school, cafeteria, or district office is returned unpaid by your bank, CISD or its agent, PayTek Recovery, will redeposit your check electronically. Additionally, you understand and agree that we may electronically collect a returned check fee of \$30.00 plus applicable sales tax. • Credit Card payments:

When paying with a credit card, the person whose name is on the credit card must be present at the time of payment.

When making an online credit card payment, the student will be given a flyer with directions for accessing the website, and procedures to follow. The payment can be made from home, or the campus will have a computer available for the parent to access at the time of preregistration.

Refunds: *Refunds for payments made via check, will not be processed for 30 days from the date payment has been made. Cash and credit card refunds can be processed once the refund form has been completed and approved.*

Financial Aid: *Financial aid is available for in-district students based on qualification for the Federal lunch program. Students and parents should discuss this with the counselor or building principal. They will communicate the need for financial aid with the summer school principal.*

Course credit will not be awarded if payment has not been received in full.

JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL GUIDELINES

1. Students, who were in the 7th or 8th grade in Conroe ISD during the 2016-2017 school year and failed, may take a maximum of 2 courses to remediate their skills. A minimum passing grade of 70 must be earned.
2. Any student dismissed from summer school because of discipline will forfeit all tuition.
3. If a student withdraws after June 8, 2016, tuition will not be refunded.
4. A student is subject to loss of credit after missing more than one day of summer school.
5. Four tardies will equate one absence.
6. Students will be properly dressed and groomed according to the standards of the regular school term.
7. Campus and CISD Code of Conduct rules will apply. Students will be given specific rules on the first day of class.
8. All CISD students will be placed in classes on a priority basis. Out-of-district students will be placed in classes based on class load availability.
9. A class must have a minimum of 15 students to be held.
10. Any student missing the last two days of summer school will not receive credit for the class.

TRANSPORTATION

Dates, times, and transportation will correspond with the Summer School programs at their respective campuses. Buses will run before school and at 11:30 am. There will **not** be a bus run at 9:30 am after Session I.
