




CISD Enrollment Trend






Attendance – 10 Year Trend






2019 Attendance Rate




2019 Annual Dropout Rate (Gr. 9-12)






Class of 2019 Four-Year Cohort: Graduation, Continued, GED, and Dropout Summary




Class of 2018 Five-Year Cohort: Graduation, Continued, GED, and Dropout Summary






2019 College Ready Graduates







2019 Percent of Students Taking AP Tests



2019 Percent of AP Tests Scored Above Criterion




2019 Dual Course Credits (Annual Graduates)






2019 Percentage Scoring at or Above Criterion on SAT/ ACT




2019 SAT Average Scores






2020-21 Tax Rate


