What's a District of Innovation?



- The 84th Legislature passed HB 1842 creating an option for Districts of Innovation in 2015.
- Provides opportunity to design an Innovation Plan according to the needs of Conroe ISD.
- Maximizes local control.

Current District of Innovation Plan



- Flexible start date (prior to the fourth Monday in August)
- Teacher certification requirements CTE only
- Our current plan expires in December 2025

District of Innovation Steps



- Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees
- Promptly after adopting resolution a public hearing is held
- At conclusion of the public hearing the board appoints a committee
- Committee develops and approves plan
- Plan is posted for at least 30 days online for feedback
- Public meeting held to review feedback and develop final version
- Seek Board approval of District of Innovation Plan

What's a District of Innovation?



- The 84th Legislature passed HB 1842 creating an option for Districts of Innovation in 2015.
- Provides opportunity to design an Innovation Plan according to the needs of Conroe ISD.
- Maximizes local control.
- Increases local flexibility.
- Provides a local approval option for exemptions other than the waiver system.
- Approval required by ⅔ membership of the Board.

Current District of Innovation Plan



- Flexible start date (prior to the fourth Monday in August)
- Teacher certification requirements CTE only
- Our current plan expires in December 2025

District of Innovation Plan



• Tonight, the Board will be asked to approve the District-Level Planning and Decision-Making Committee (DLPDMC), which is made up of teachers, parents, community members, and administrators as the District of Innovation Committee. If approved, this committee will develop a plan and place it on the District's web site for 30 days. During that time, the committee will take feedback.

Possible Areas to Consider



- Expand teacher certifications to include additional hard to fill positions
- Flexibility in teacher contracts
- Teacher appraisals- Student Learning Objectives (SLO)
- Campus Behavior Coordinator designation

Draft Timeline



- November 14th Resolution, public hearing, appointment of committee
- December 6th Committee develops and approves plan
- December 7th Plan is posted for at least 30 days online for feedback
- January 10th Public committee meeting to review the feedback and vote on plan to present to board
- January 15th Seek Board approval of District of Innovation Plan
