




Attendance – 10 Year Trend




2020 Attendance Rate



10 Year Enrollment Trend for Students with Disciplinary Placements




2020 Annual Dropout Rate (Gr. 9-12)






Class of 2020 Four-Year Cohort: Graduation, Continuers, GED, and Dropout Summary



Class of 2019 Five-Year Cohort: Graduation, Continuers, GED, and Dropout Summary




2021 STAAR Percent at Approaches Grade Level or Above - All Subjects






2021 STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level or Above - All Subjects







2021 STAAR Percent at Masters Grade Level or Above - All Subjects

2020 Career or Military Ready Annual Graduates




2020 Percent of Students Taking AP Tests



2020 Percent of AP Tests Scored Above Criterion




2020 Dual Course Credits (Annual Graduates)






2020 Percentage Scoring at or Above Criterion on SAT/ ACT






2021-22 Tax Rate


