 RAVE 911 has been piloted at Grand Oaks High School and York Junior High School


Approval

- Asking for your approval of the Memorandum of Understanding with the Montgomery County Emergency Communication District
- This will allow us to finalize payment of our required portion covering three years of use and move forward with the implementation of RAVE 911 for all C.I.S.D. campuses



Senate Bill (SB) 838

- Recently signed bill SB 838 requires Texas school districts to implement a panic alert system that allows campus staff to initiate immediate contact with law enforcement agencies, health departments, and fire departments
- Requires Texas school districts to have a system in place for the 2025-2026 school year
- With your approval of the MOU, we will implement RAVE 911 for the 2023-2024 school year



What is Silent Panic Alert Technology?

An application that can be loaded by all *school staff* to report a variety of emergencies

Also offers non-life threatening emergency communications and notification options to staff

Notes:

- Downloading the app would be optional for staff
- Staff can elect to receive messages via text without downloading the app

How does it work?

- The software calls 911 when an alert is sent from a campus staffer
- It notifies:
 - 911 and appropriate first responders immediately
 - campus-based staff
 - gives first responders access to campus maps
 - allows first responders to obtain real-time ongoing updates

RAVE 911 Training

- Training for school staff will occur at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year
- The required training is currently being developed by the Conroe ISD Police Department and includes information explaining:
 - The RAVE Panic Button app and its purpose
 - How to download and utilize the app
 - Frequently asked questions
