### YMCA Partnership

- The YMCA provides after school care at 24 of our elementary campuses.
- Families at these campuses are offered quality child care in which tuition is based on a sliding scale that is dependent on family income.
- The YMCA was awarded a grant through the Texas Workforce Commission to enhance their programs including their after school programs that are hosted at local, public schools.
- All 24 campuses received benefits from this grant including additional staffing, various staff benefits to attract quality employees as well as covering the cost of child care for families experiencing financial difficulties.
- Once these expenses at each location were encumbered, the YMCA identified 16 campuses with funds remaining in the grant.
