

High School Name Suggestion	Rationale for Name Suggestion
Beach High School	According to the history of Conroe, the location of the very first public school was in the Beach community. The new high school is also being built in Beach area. Naming it Beach High School would both honor the first public schools location and be a geographical reference. I did also consider Conroe Beach as a possibility. This would be similar to The Woodland College Park High School's name.
Bear Creek High School	Proximity to bear creek
Bear Creek High School	Near the site of the new high school, North of LP336, behind Waste Management's fuel station lies the East Fork of Crystal Creek.  Until the 1930's, this creek was called Bear Creek, & noted as such on maps.  In his autobiography, frontier preacher, J.W Anderson, who frequently stopped in Conroe, spoke of the great numbers of bears in this area.  The name Bear Creek confirms this observation; & as our history slips further away we should recognize the wildlife that once roamed Conroe's forests
C.T High School	I suggest C.T High School it is short for Conroe, Texas.
Cedar Forest High School	Cedar because the Conroe community built its early economy on the lumber industry.  Forest for the proximity to Sam Houston National Forest.
Cedar Woods High School	Based on cedar in the street names in the hidden creek preserve neighborhood, and woods from the Barton woods and Creighton woods Neighborhoods.
Central High (Home of the Clydesdale)	The location is inside the loop which surrounds the center of Conroe!
Central High School	The new school will be between Conroe High School and schools farther in east county.
Cliff View High School	It's the name of the subdivision that's in the neighborhood. It's different and does not have the name ranch, creek, oak or ridge like other high schools in our district and others.
Conroe Beach High School	To honor the historical site of Beach, TX, located just south of the planned high school location on State Highway 105 about two miles east of downtown Conroe. This community began in the late 1800s as a sawmill town and was a stop on the Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway. Isaac Conroe, founder of nearby Conroe, chose the location for a sawmill to take advantage of the burgeoning timber industry in the region. He named the site Beach.
Conroe Crystal Creek	With both East and West Fork of Crystal Creek being nearby it makes sense. Mascots that could go with the name: Captains (Conroe-North Houston Airport being nearby) , Copperheads and Catfish; all Animals that are in Montgomery County/Conroe, but a little less generic. Color schemes of Brown/Bronze/Gold/Black would look good with all of these mascots as well.
Conroe east	High schools are named after their towns. I'm sure one day there will be more high schools for the area might as well just give them directional names!
Conroe East High School	Just like Magnolia's new high school is Magnolia West, it makes sense. People will know the school is located in Conroe and will know it is the high school on the East side of town or I-45. The new high school will have Conroe in the name but will have its own identity as well.

Conroe East High School	Geographical location of the new campus is on the east side of Conroe and the current Conroe High School

Conroe Mill High School	"In 1886, the Conroe Public School's first classes were held in a one-room school constructed of rough lumber near the present community of Beach; It was called Conroe Mill School and was open each year for a five-month term."  Given the location of the new high school campus, the name Conroe Mill High School would pay homage to the area it serves and the history of the City of Conroe and Conroe ISD
Conroe Mills High School	Due to Isaac Conroe's history as an illustrious railroad man and lumberjack, this name nods to the historic nature of Conroe's birth as a lumber town, where Isaac operated the mills. A mascot could be the lumberjacks.
Conroe North High School	The new school is off the north 336 loop and is in the northern region of Conroe.
Conroe Northeast High School	The school's location from the center of the city.
Conroe Park/ Conroe Park West/Stewart /Davis	All geographical areas near the location.
Conroe Pines High School	Conroe, because approximately half of Conroe will feed into this school, and to reference Conroe high school that they currently attend. Also pines would reflect the many wooded areas with pine trees in this area.

Pine Forest High School	Conroe is a forested area and many of our existing school have a tree name,( OAK Ridge, Grand OAKS, THE WOODLANDS, etc)
Pine forest Highschool or Woodland pines Highschool	There are a lot of oak names so keeping it within the tree family names. Conroe is know for its big forest of trees
Piney Mill or Pine Mill High School	nod to one of the original industries in the area
Piney Woods High	The Piney Woods is a geographical area which covers a good part of Eastern Texas and also stretches to parts of Louisiana and Arkansas. The Woods have been heavily depleted due to the lumber industry, but still the name remains for the geographical area. Specifically, Conroe is part of the Southern tertiary area of this region. We might as well honor all the trees that have been destroyed to build up our community.
Piney Woods High School	Conroe was built as a lumber town. It's geographically significant to the native pine trees in the area and is significant to the town's history. Mascot suggestion - Lumberjacks
Piney Woods High School	Before development, the area use to be known as the piney wooded area.
River Mill High School	Brings together the proximity to rivers and the milling industry
San Jacinto High School	The San Jacinto River has so much historical significance to the entire area from the Indians who lived along the banks of the river, to damming it to creat Lake Conroe and many other historical happenings along the River banks.
