Call to Order

Mr. Haymark called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. and thanked everyone for attending.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the January 25, 2022 SHAC meeting were reviewed by Mr. Haymark and approved as submitted.

Update on Proclamation 2022 / District Instructional Materials Selection Committee Final Review and Recommendation

Mr. Haymark shared the results of the teacher evaluation of the Health and Physical Education instructional materials. Purchase proposal information for Texas Health Skills for Middle School, Texas Health Skills for High School, and Texas Fitness and Wellness Skills was shared and explained. House Bill 1525 and Senate Bill 9 were reviewed, and Mr. Haymark explained how the Opt-In requirements of both legislative bills have been removed from the main text by Goodheart-Willcox and have been released as a companion text to the middle school and high school Health textbooks. The chapters and topics within the companion texts were shared with the SHAC. A copy of the current CISD Parent Consent Form (Opt-In) was shared. Mr. Haymark provided information about the SHAC - approved video for human growth and development currently shown to 5th and 6th graders. Information about CATCH Health and Physical Education for elementary instruction was reviewed. Mr. Haymark discussed that the CISD Board of Trustees will consider the SHAC's recommendation at the next board meeting and that the IMA Committee will meet to discuss the approval of purchases.

Dr. Hines provided an explanation of the IMA (Instructional Materials Allotment) Committee.

Candace Franklin asked about the parent review of materials. Mr. Haymark explained that only one parent commented on the instructional materials under review and that the comments were not specific to any of the materials under review.



Bryce Speer commented on the limited choices parents have in regard to this adoption. Dr. Hines explained that the State Board of Education approved only one resource for school districts to consider for adoption.

Ana Lanni expressed concern over students taking the Health required course for graduation late into their high school career and not receiving Health instruction earlier. Mr. Haymark explained that Health TEKS are written for all grade levels. Dr. Hines explained that the Health 1 course was predominately for 9th graders, but due to scheduling concerns, the class is now offered to 8th graders for high school credit. Dr. Povich explained that the majority of high school students take the Health 1 course early to allow room for senior courses.
