The meeting will be conducted by videoconference and/or audio conference due to health and safety concerns related to the COVID-19 virus and as allowed by Governor Abbott's Temporary Suspension of Open Meetings Laws issued on March 16, 2020. A quorum of the Committee will be participating by videoconference or telephone call in accordance with Texas Government Code Section 552.125 and 551.127. These provisions were not suspended by the Governor's order.
