CISD Naloxone Program Expansion

- S.B. 629
- Approved by the House and Senate
- Signed by Governor Abbott June 18, 2023
- Status: Effective September 1, 2023
 - Awaiting rules from Health and Human Services
- Requires all school districts to adopt a policy on maintenance, administration, and disposal of opioid antagonists at each campus serving students in 6th grade and above. District's may *choose* to also adopt a policy for grades lower than 6th.
- Requires at least one authorized and trained individual on each campus during regular school hours.
- Provides for possible funding.






Current Naloxone Program & Needed Additions

Current Conroe ISD Naloxone Program includes:

- Multiple doses of naloxone on Jr. High and High School campuses housed or carried by:
 - Clinic
 - Athletic Training rooms
 - Each CISD police officer
- Training was provided for all nurses, clinic assistants, athletic trainers, and police officers
- Additions needed to our current Naloxone Program to comply with S.B. 629:
 - Supply Intermediate campuses and Flex campuses with naloxone doses
 - Determine if we expand current program to all campuses in the District
 - Determine how many doses each campus must maintain
 - Acquire additional naloxone doses based on new program guidelines
 - Determine storage location on campuses
 - Expand employee training to all campus administrators and possibly campus emergency response team members. Training may also include school volunteers.


