# Safety Audit Rotations

## Three Year Rotation Cycles

- 2019-2020: Finish the last three-year-rotation of Safety Audits for Conroe Independent School District
- 2020-2021: Started the new three-year-rotation of Safety Audits for Conroe Independent School District
  - Conroe High School Feeder Zone—Spring Semester (2021)
  - Caney Creek High School Feeder Zone—Spring Semester (2021)
  - District Facilities—Fall Semester (2020)

# Why do we do Safety Audits

- Ongoing process with the aim of identifying hazards, threats, and vulnerabilities that might pose danger to life or property
- To ensure a safe, secure and healthy environment that is conducive to teaching and learning

# What is a Safety Audit

- Consist of Audit Team: Usually the Assistant Principal responsible for safety on the campus and myself. May include the Principal of the campus. Teachers and staff are included throughout the process via question and answers done during audit
- Conduct Intruder Assessment
- Review of Multihazard Emergency Operating Procedures
- Report of findings
- Correction of any issues discovered during audit

# What are we looking for?

## Most Common Examples

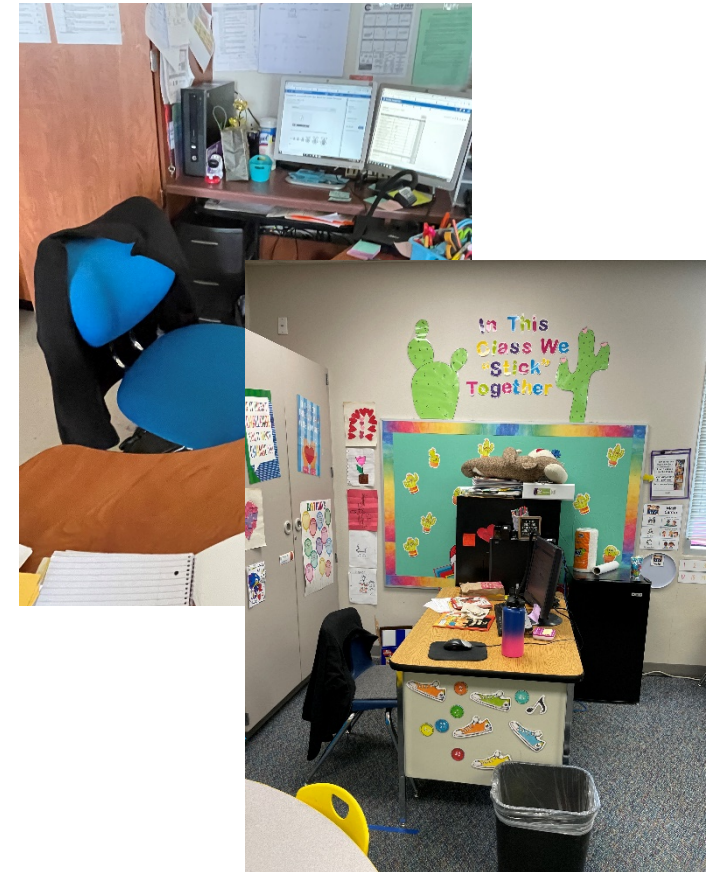

- Non-contact thermometers
  - 69
- Medium gloves
  - 80 boxes
- N95
  - 1994 box/50
- Surgical ear loop masks
  - 1080 box/50
- Adult cloth masks
  - 191 cases/500
- Youth cloth masks
  - 91 cases/500



# Receive Information, Validate Existing Inventory and Replacement Schedule Regarding Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

## Inventory items:

- Small gloves - 360 boxes
- Medium gloves - 309 boxes
- Large gloves - 455 boxes
- XL gloves - 148 boxes
- Face shields - 824 each
- Sneeze guards - 5 each
- CTE Sneeze guards - 65 each
- Hanging barriers - 62 each
- Hand sanitizer REFILLS for stands - 5,886 cases/6

# Receive Information, Validate Existing Inventory and Replacement Schedule Regarding Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

## Inventory Items (cont):

- KN95 masks - 430 pk/5
- Medical masks (ear loop) - 1175 box/50
- Disinfectant wipes buckets - 311 each
- Wipes refills for buckets - 604 cases of 6
- Gallon refills - hand sanitizer - 479 cases/4
- Desktop hand sanitizer - 3,286 cases/12
- Face shields from Sam's -
  - Adult - 701 packs/4
  - Kids - 37 packs/3
- Personal protection kit (mask, face shield, gloves, etc,) - 1126 packs/2

# Receive Information, Validate Existing Inventory and Replacement Schedule Regarding Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- PPE is available by request through the CISD warehouse and Health Services
- Campuses are made aware of what is available by warehouse supervisor and also have been given funds to purchase PPE items through awarded PPE vendors through the district's bid (Awarded October 2020)
- Replacement is currently in the budget
  - These monies could be repurposed depending on actual needs

The Conroe Independent School District School Safety and Security Committee approve the Conroe ISD Multihazard Operations Plans for the 2021-2022 school year.

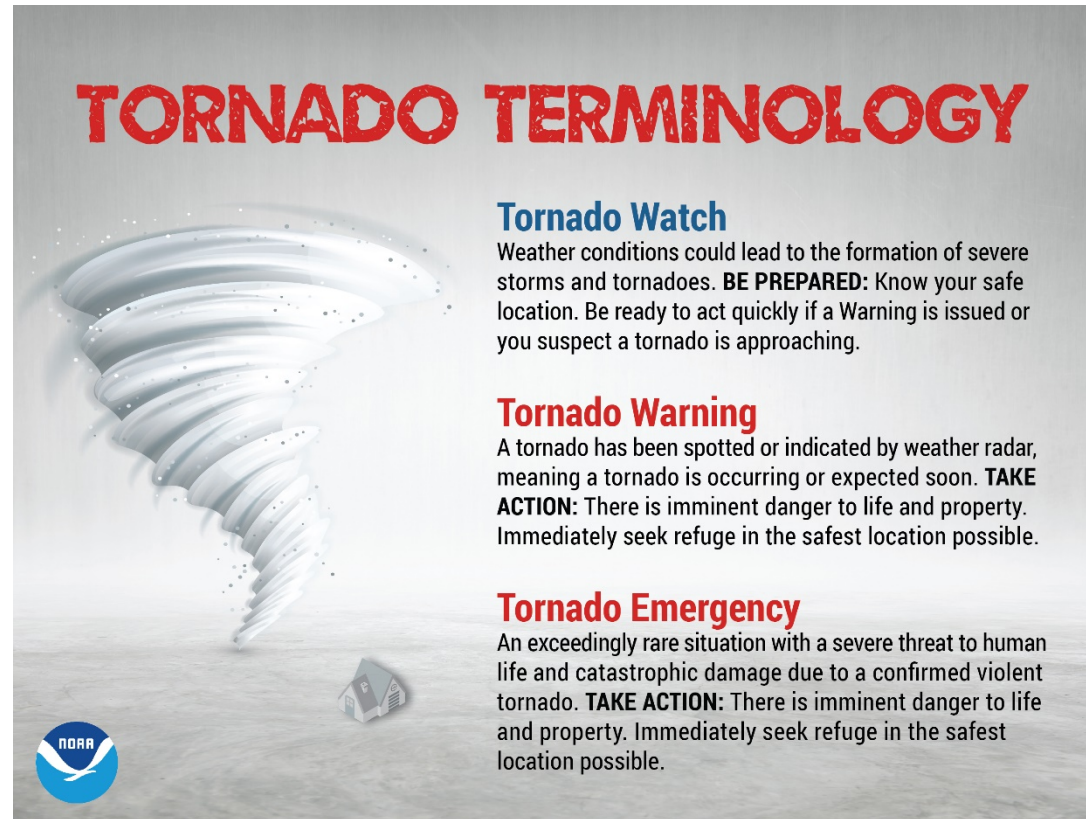

# Multihazard Emergency Operations Plan (MEOP) Committee Recommendations

- Texas Education Code §37.109 requires that the School Safety and Security Committee “provide recommendations . . . regarding updating the [MEOP] . . .”

- Date and name changes, as appropriate
- Addition of tornado response language elaboration
  - Reduce confusion from a watch to a warning
