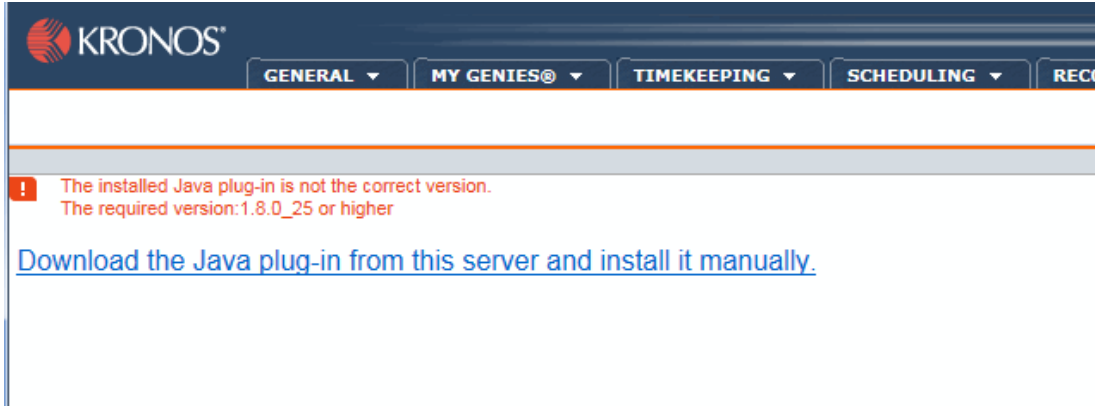


Java for Kronos

Kronos will function best on Java version 8 Update 121. That is the version Kronos will download for you if you remove Java from your machine. If prompted to update Java say no.

If the current version of Java is between version 8 update 25 and version 8 update 121, and you are utilizing Google Chrome for Kronos, **do not update Java**. Google Chrome no longer supports Java. If you update Java, Kronos on Google Chrome will no longer function and you will need to use Internet Explorer for Kronos.



Confirming version of Java

1. Launch the **Windows Start** menu
2. Find the **Java** program listing



3. Click **About Java** to see the Java version

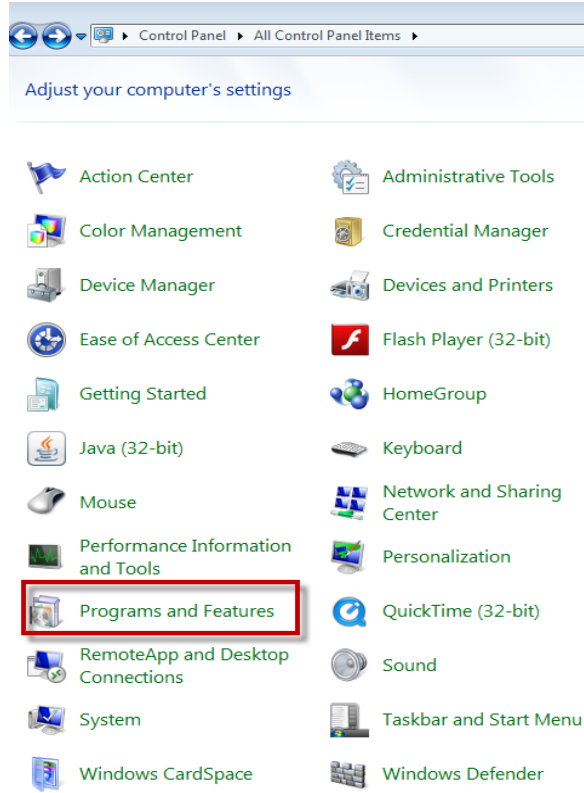


4. If Java is between Version 8 Update 25, and Version 8 Update 121 no need to update.

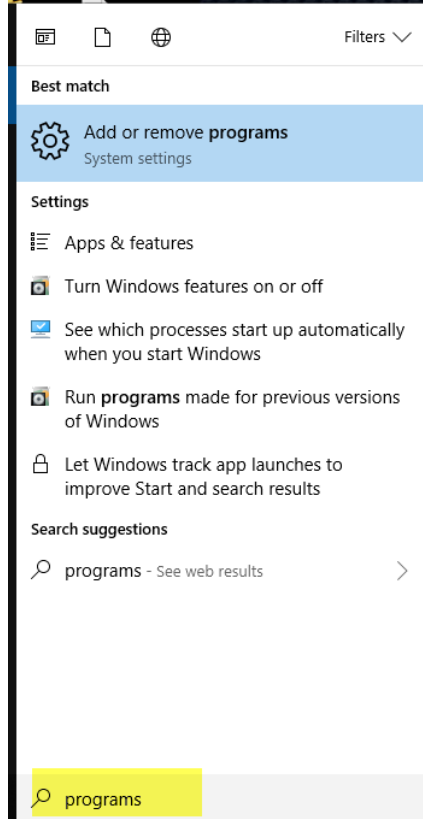
Upgrading version of Java

Navigate to Control Panel – Programs and Features(Windows 7) Add/Remove Programs(Windows 10) -

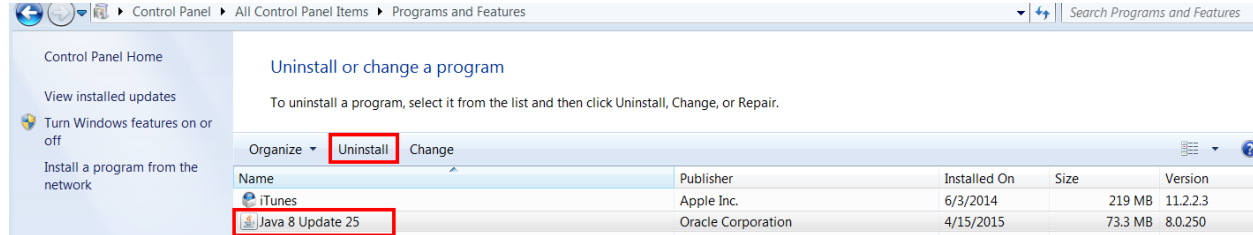
Window 7/Windows Vista



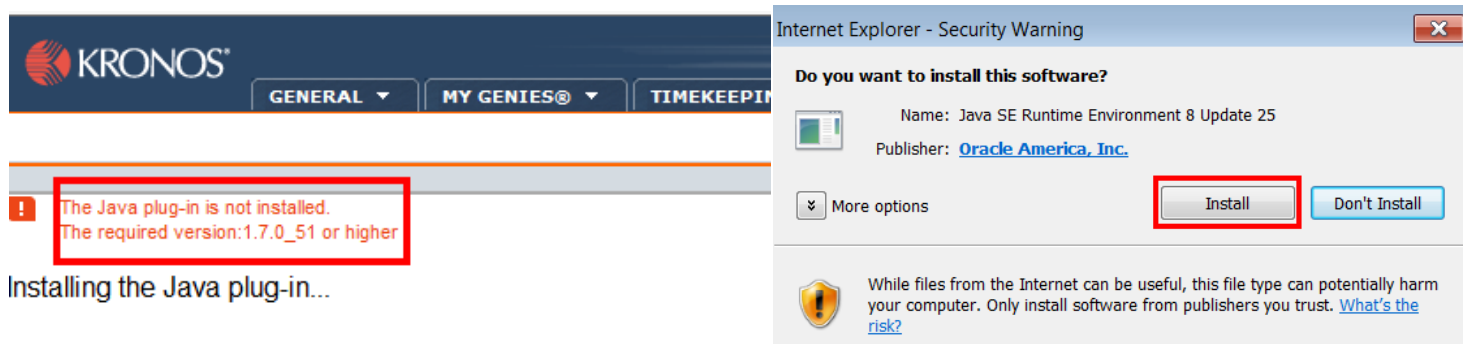
Windows 10



Click on Java and Click Uninstall



Once Java is Uninstalled, Login to Kronos Manager Login. An Error Message and prompt to install Java will be displayed, click Install.

**Installing Java through Kronos will ensure you are using the correct version

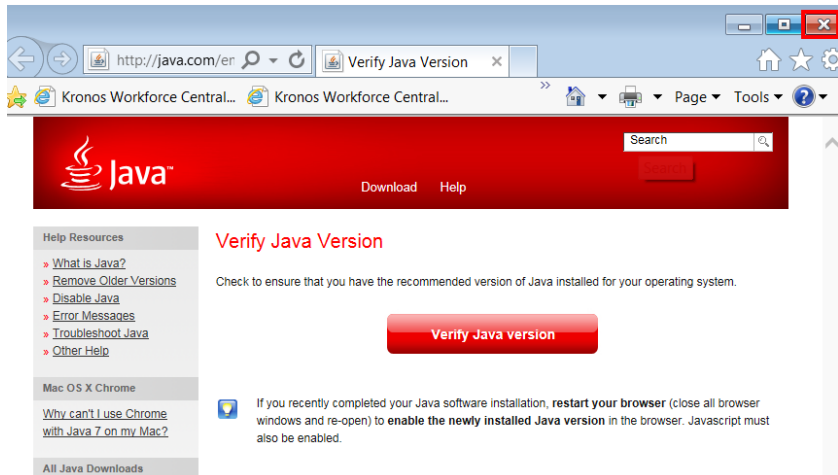
Click Install

Exit Out, Do Not Click Agree and continue. If you do, the current version of Java will be load which is not compatible with Kronos. Kronos will not function.
