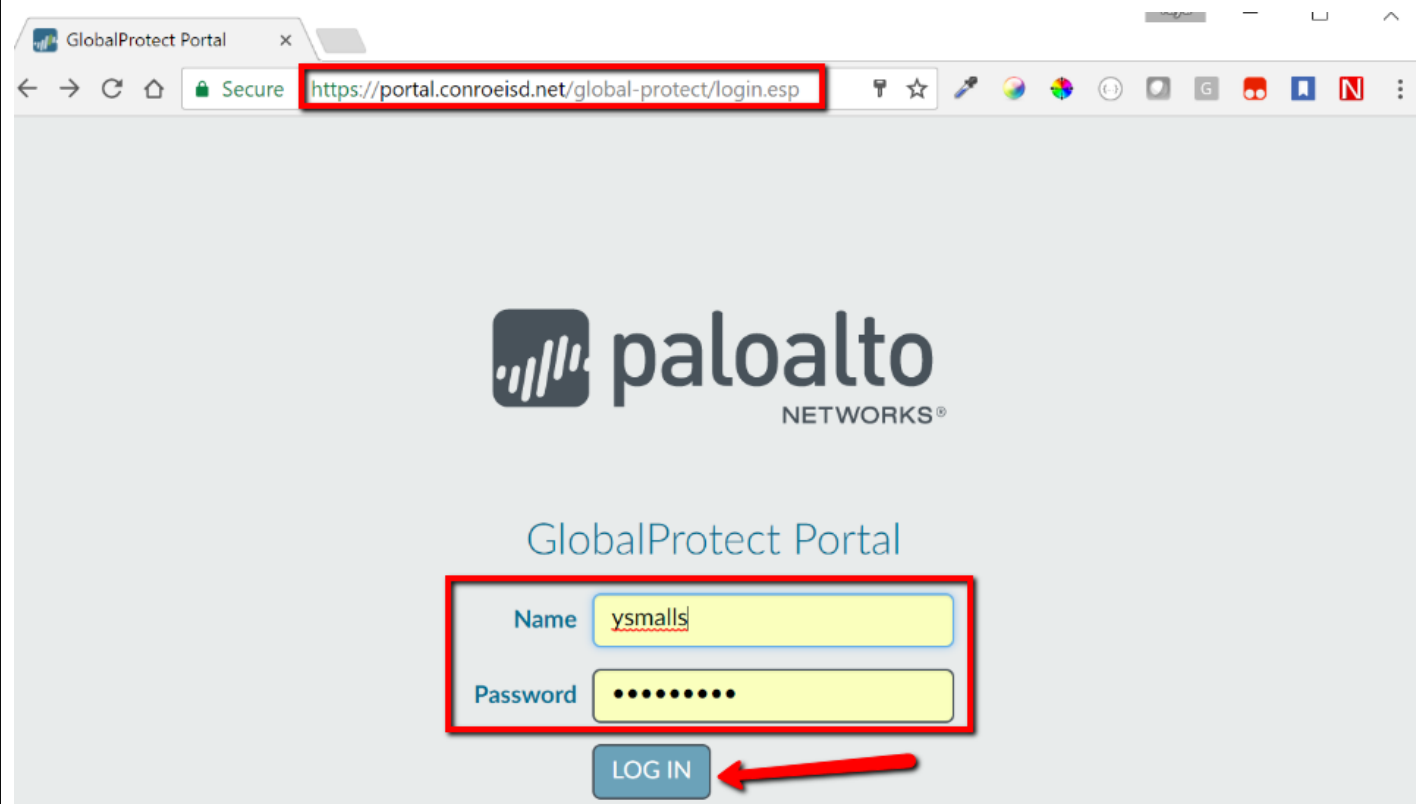


VPN for Windows

VPN connection only works when accessing the network from **OUTSIDE THE DISTRICT**.

Below are the steps to help you connect your Windows 10 device to VPN (steps are similar if you are running an older operating system):

- ◆ Open web browser of choice
- ◆ Type <https://portal.conroeisd.net> in the URL address bar
- ◆ Name and Password are same as domain credentials
- ◆ Select "LOG IN"



NOTE: We strongly recommend that **Cisco AnyConnect** be uninstalled from your device before GlobalProtect is installed. Page 10 of this handout has steps to uninstall.

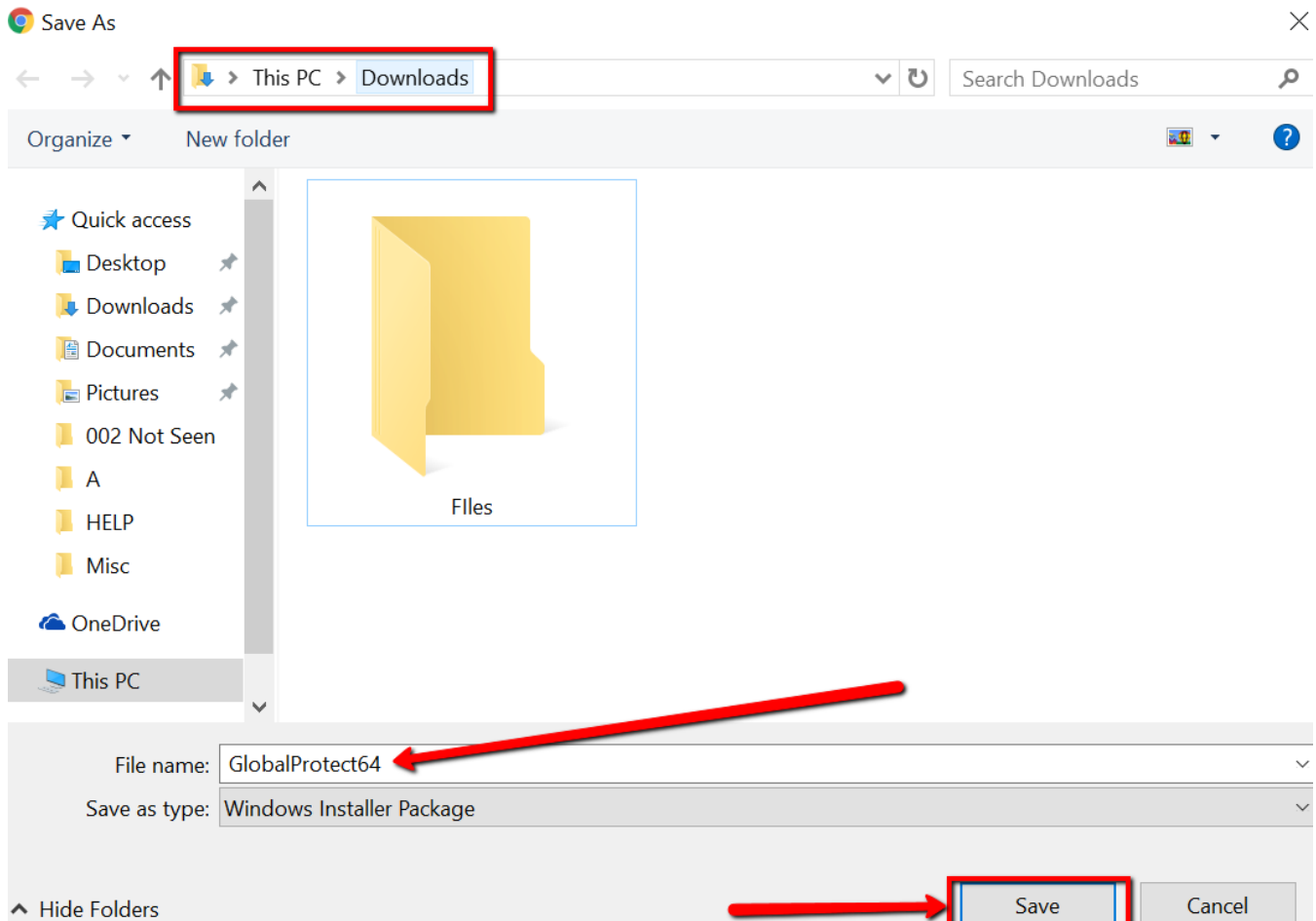

Windows 32 bit OS needs to download and install Windows 32 bit GlobalProtect agent.

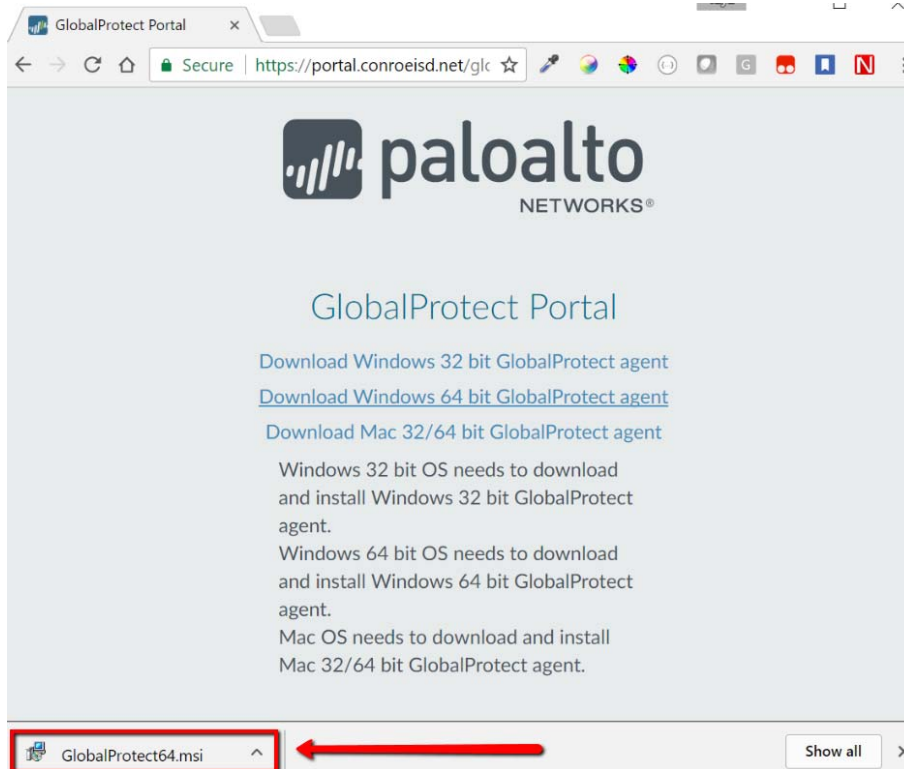
Windows 64 bit OS needs to download and install Windows 64 bit GlobalProtect agent.

Mac OS needs to download and install Mac 32/64 bit GlobalProtect agent.

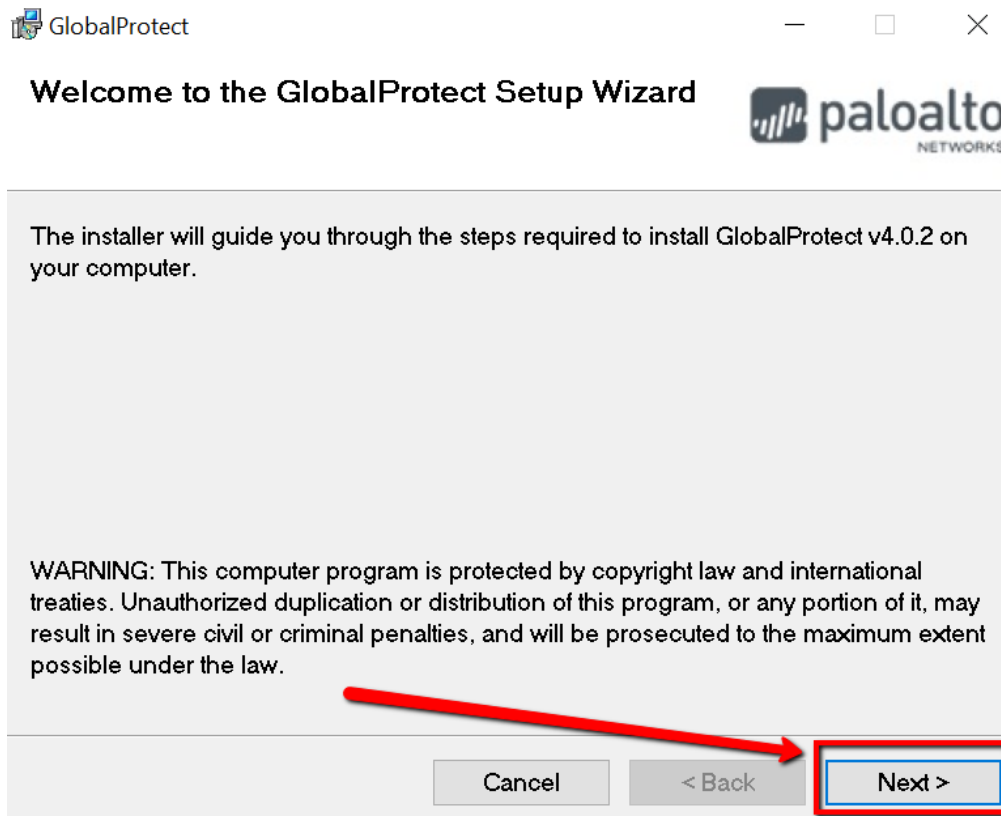
Click **"Save"** to save the *GlobalProtect64* file that needs to be installed.



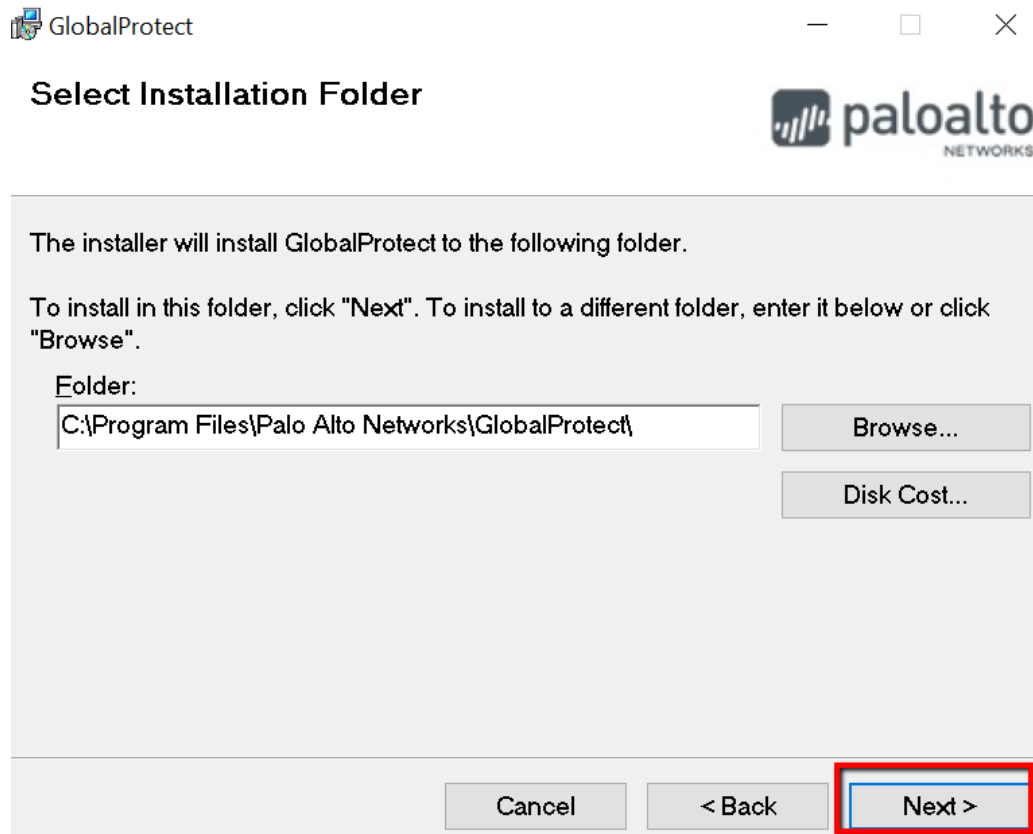
Once download is complete you will see the file name on the bottom of your browser screen, click on the file name to start installation process:



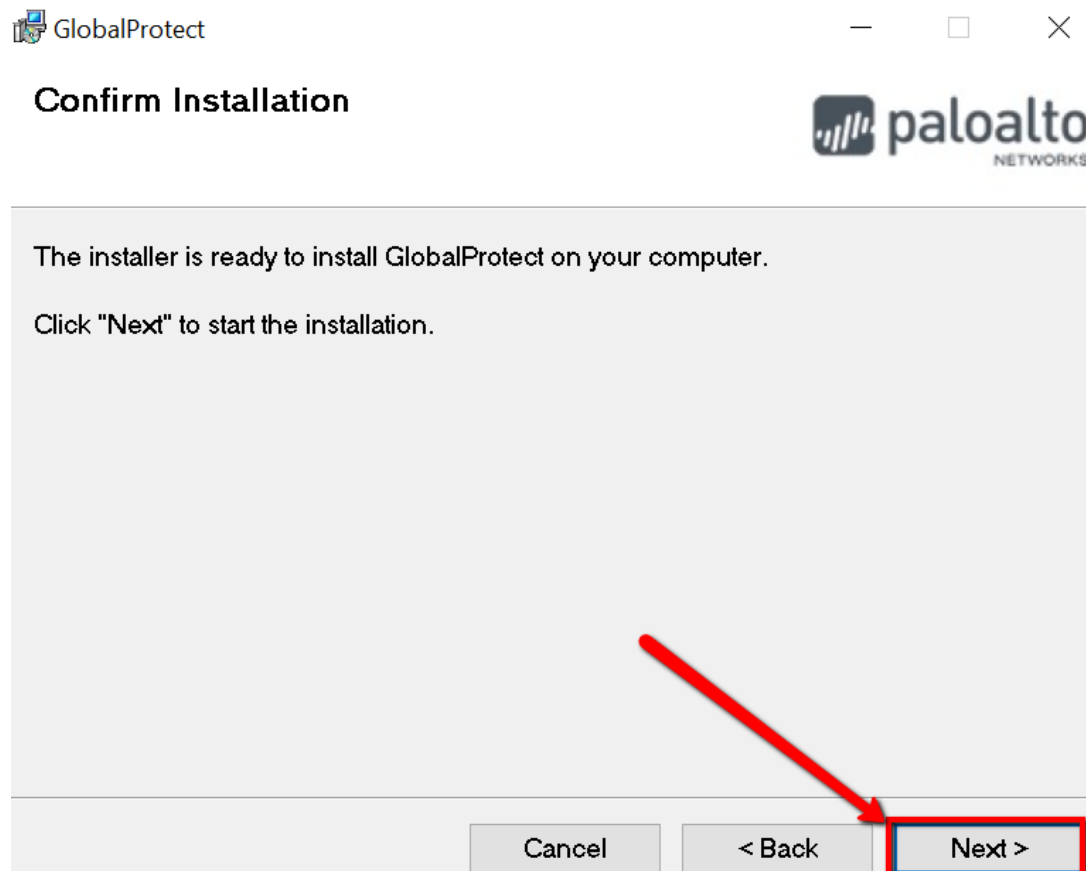
Click "Next" to continue with the GlobalProtect Setup Wizard:



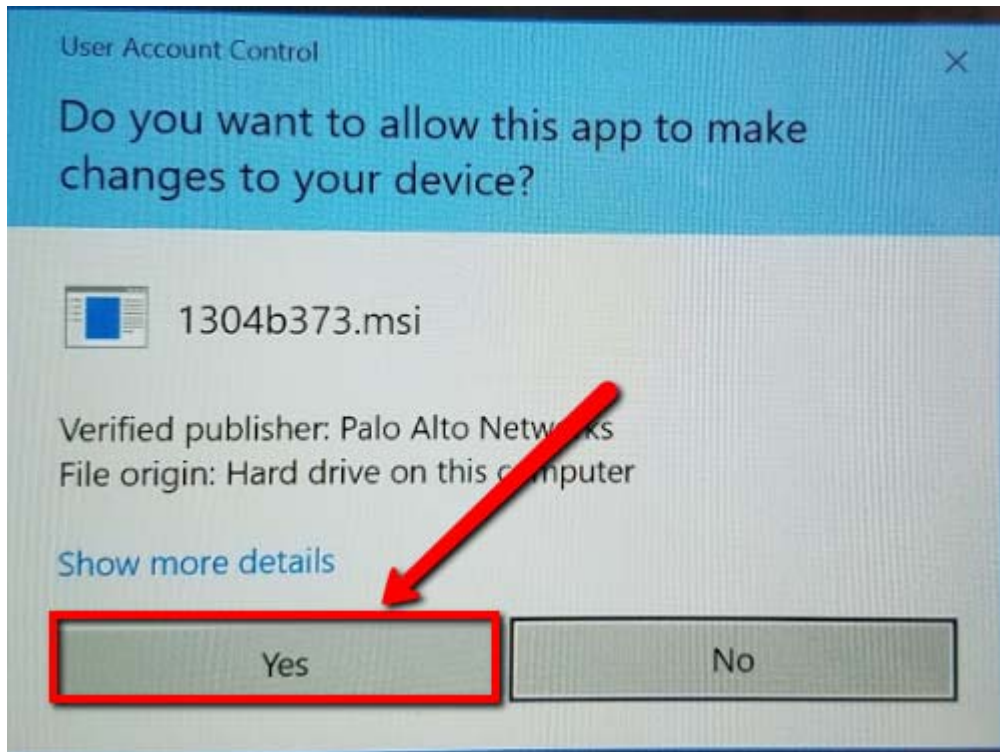
Select Installation Folder, leave default and click "Next":



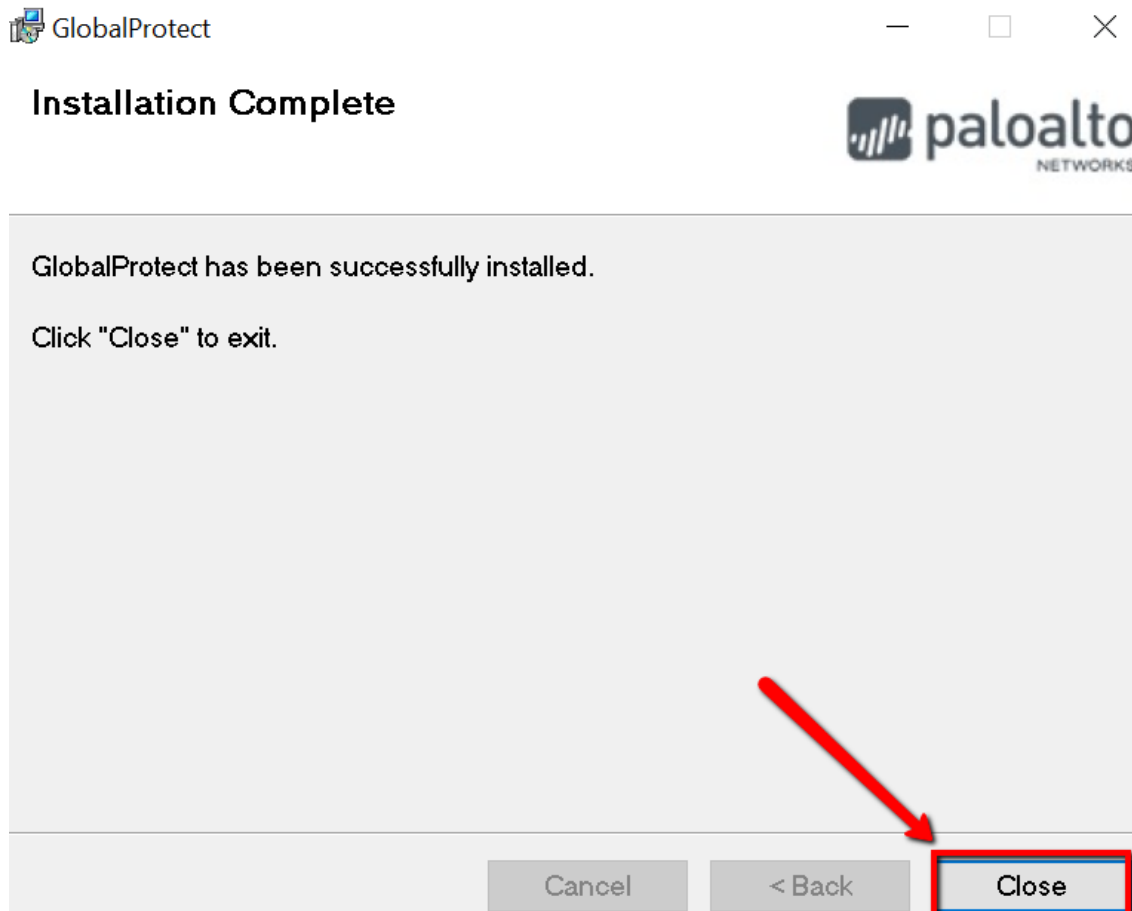
Click "Next" to confirm installation:



Click **"Yes"**, to allow installation:



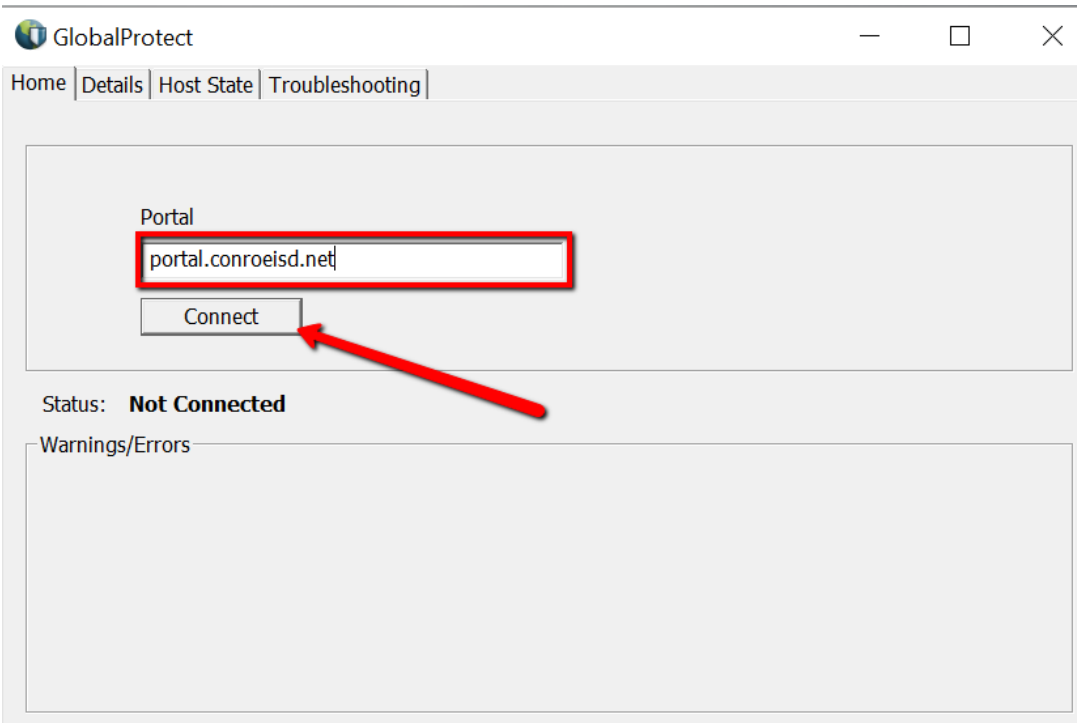
Click **"Close"** from the installation complete pop-up screen:

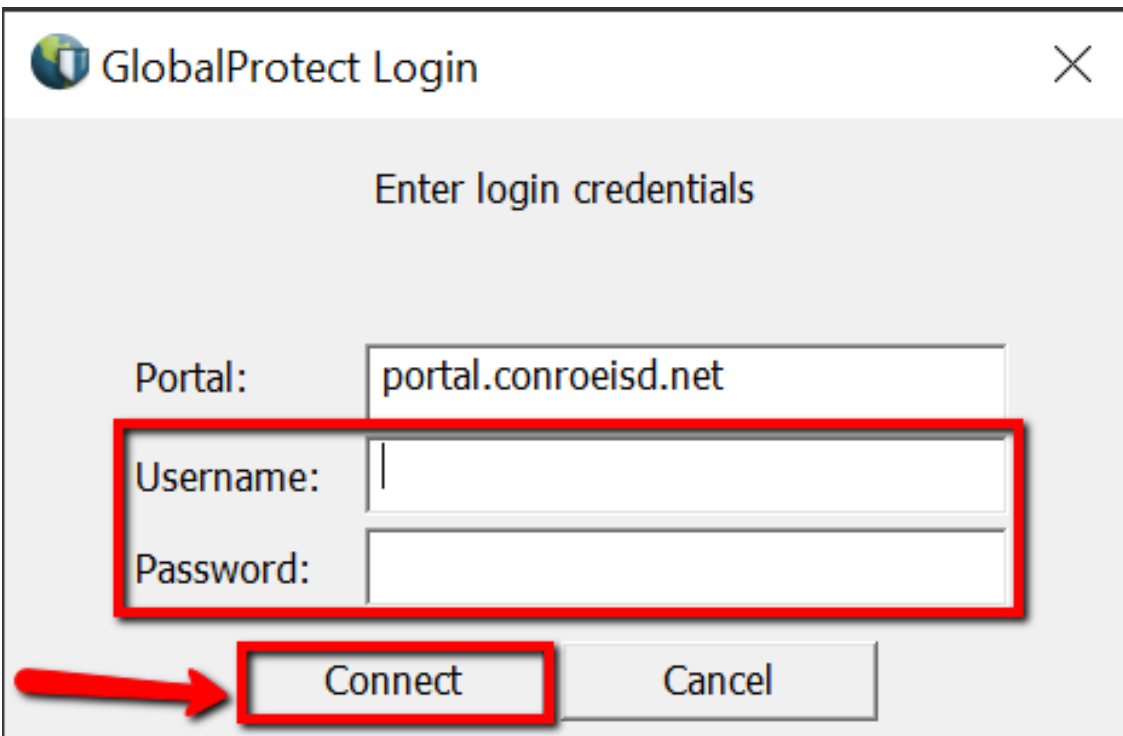
Click "Connect" after you type in the district portal:



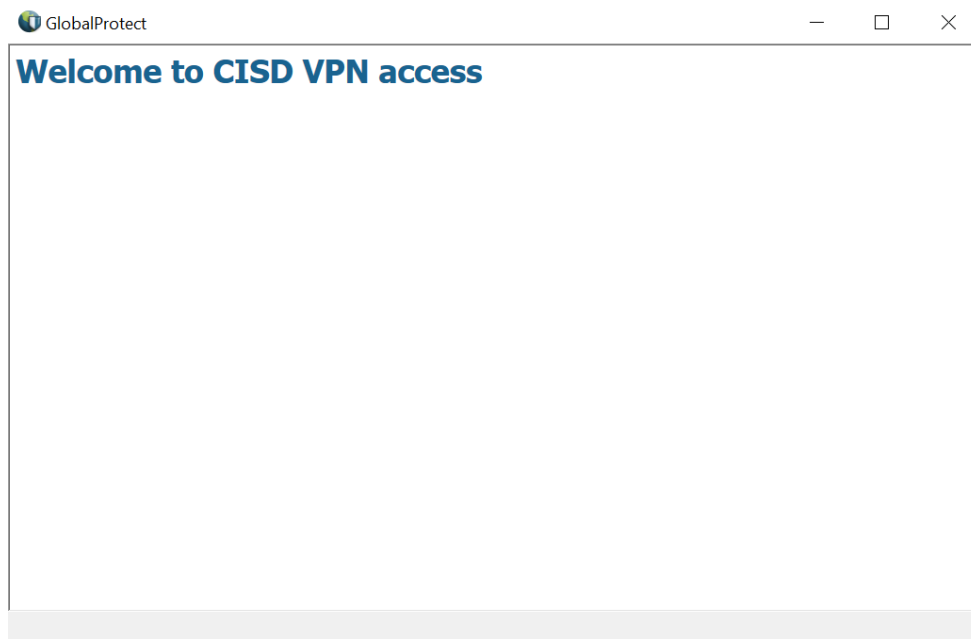
GlobalProtect Login Screen.

Username and Password are same as your domain login credentials.

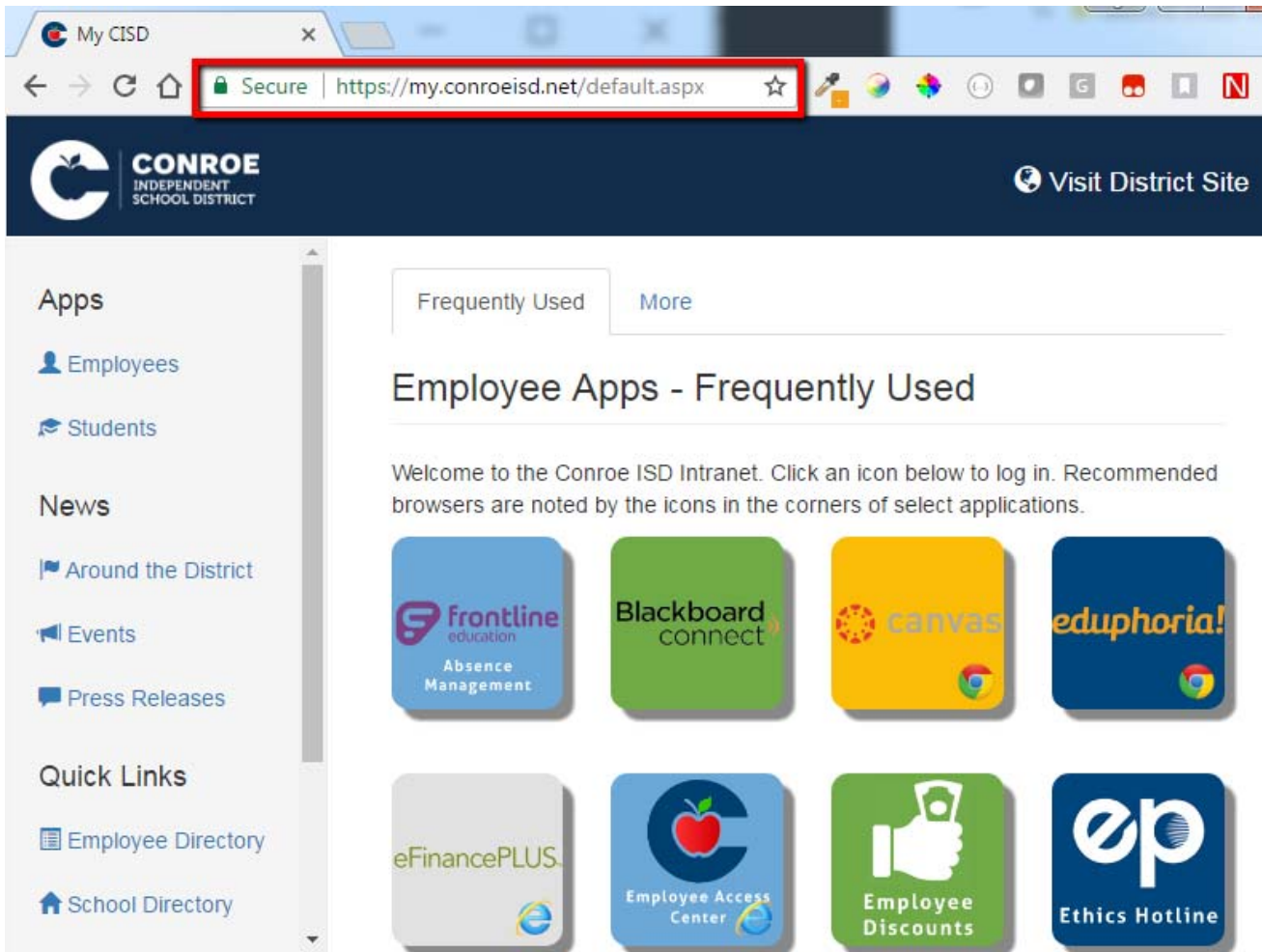
Click "**Connect**" :



You are connected once you see the "Welcome to CISD VPN access" screen:

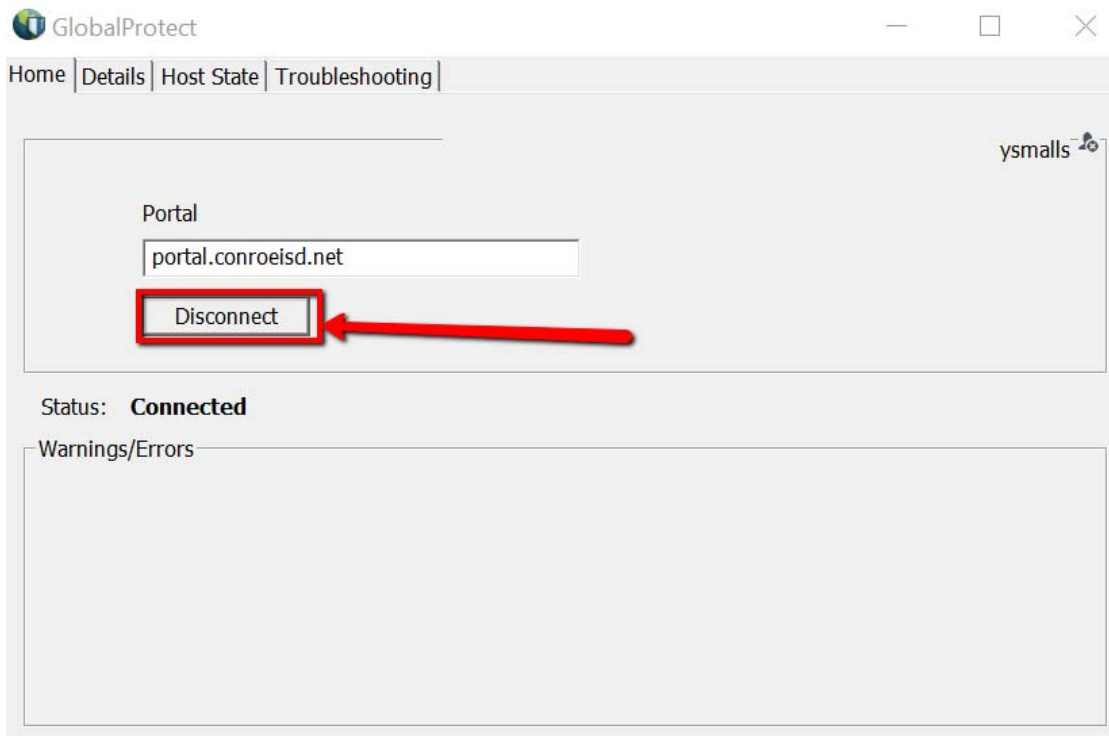


Open browser of choice, in URL address type **my.conroeisd.net** to access the districts intranet:

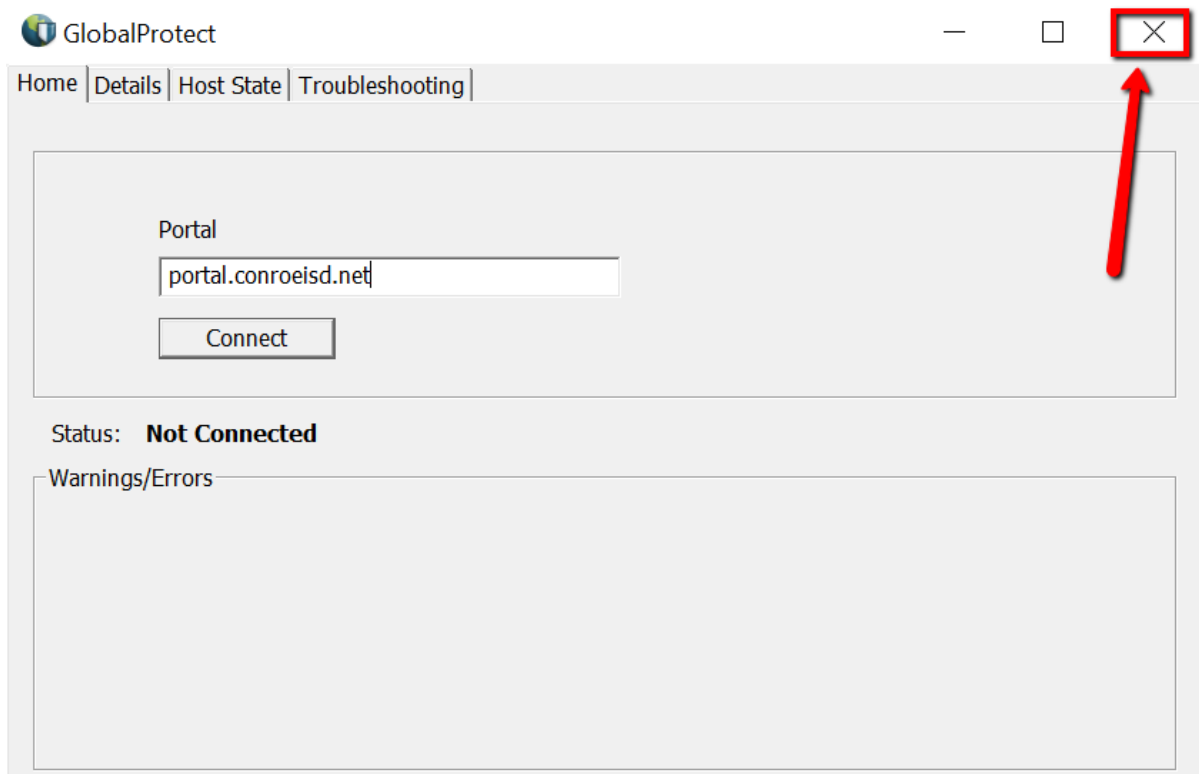


Keep this screen in the background.

Click "**Disconnect**" to disconnect from VPN:



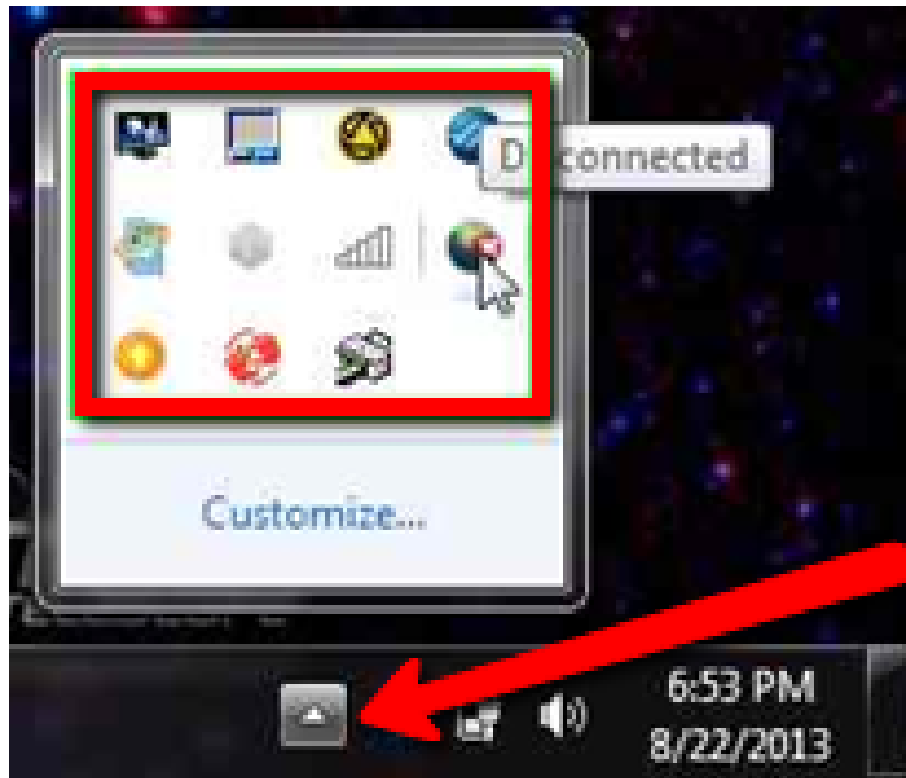
Close GlobalProtect screen after you disconnect:



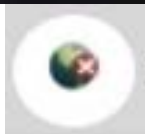
To connect to VPN with the GlobalProtect Client after initial installation.

Hover your mouse over the GlobalProtect icon to display the "Disconnected" status:

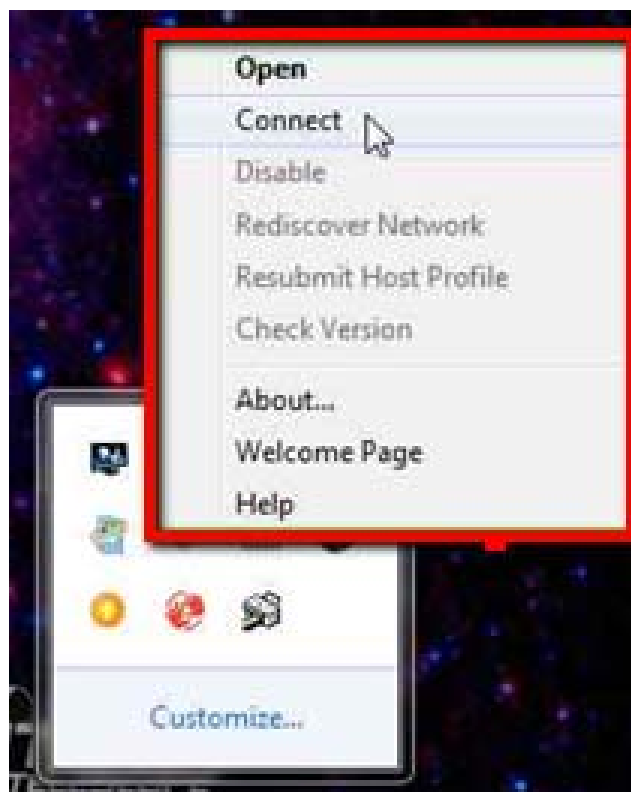


Double click on the GlobalProtect



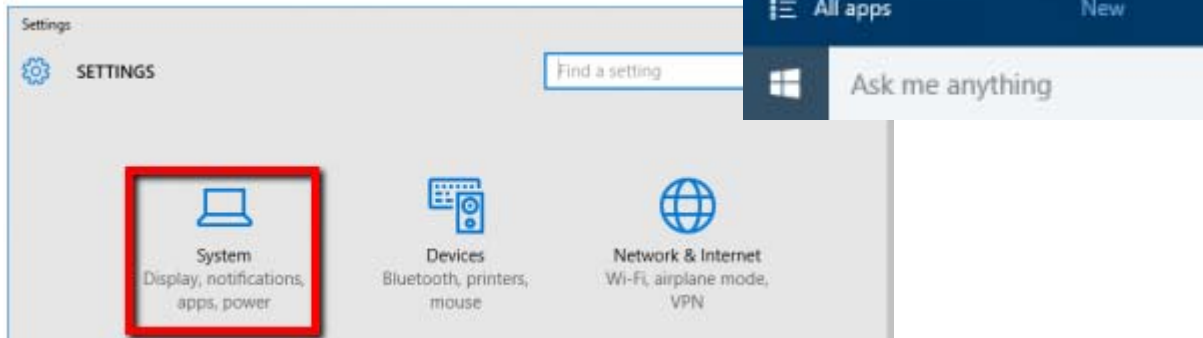
icon to display login screen or right-click to open

the options menu and select "Connect":

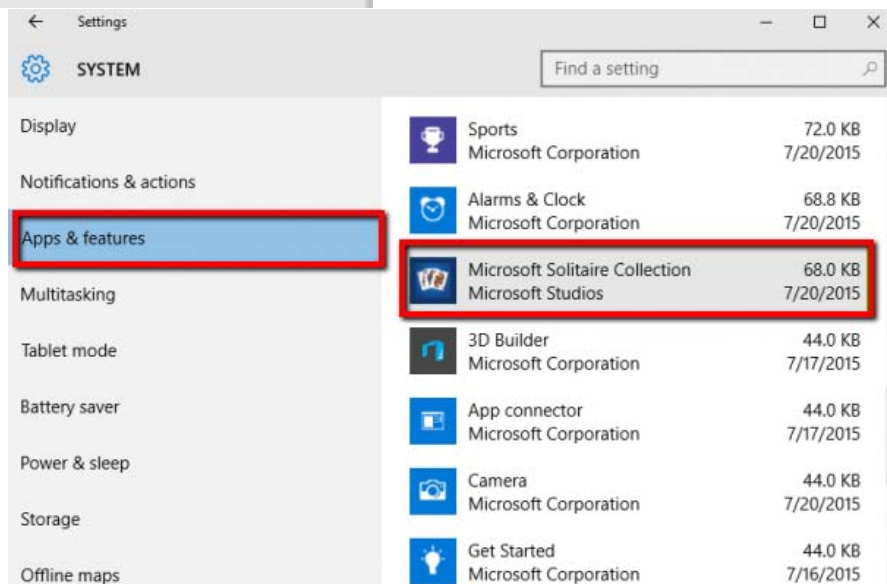


How to Uninstall an application in Windows 10.

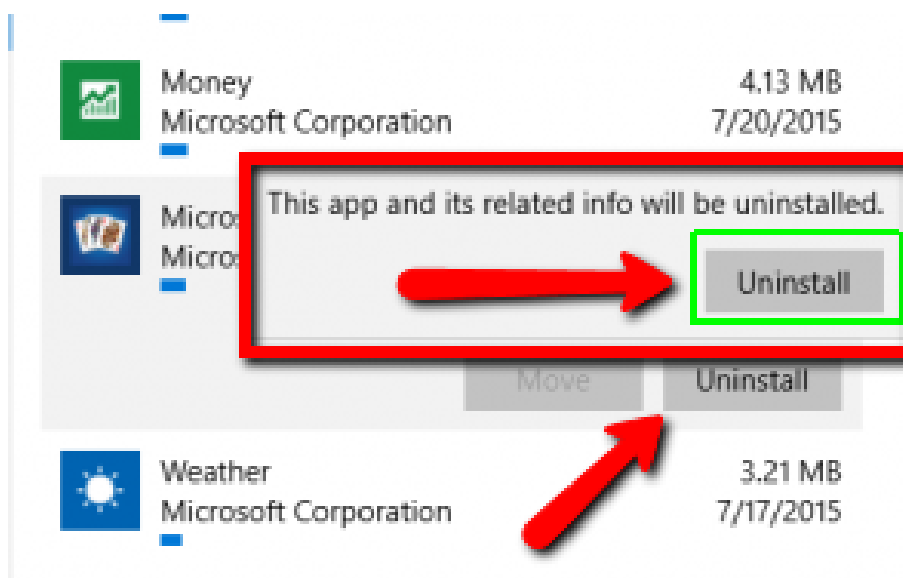
- ◆ Open **Start** menu
- ◆ Click on **Settings**
- ◆ Click on **System** on the Settings menu



- ◆ Select **Apps & Features** from the left pane
- ◆ Select the **App** you wish to Uninstall

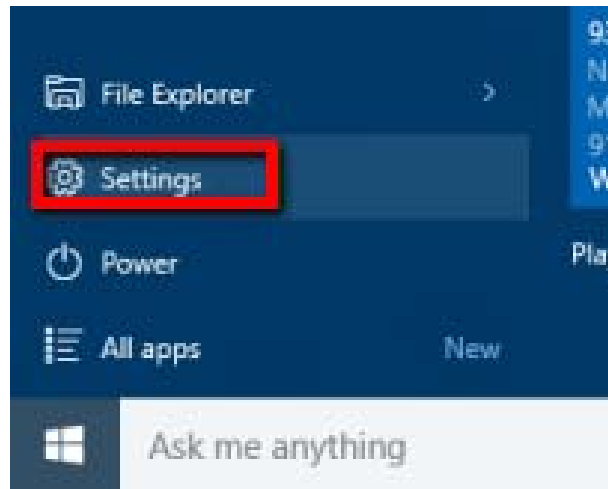


- ◆ Click the **Uninstall** button then click the **Uninstall** pop-up button to confirm

- ◆ Open **Start** menu
- ◆ Click on **Settings**
