

FINE ARTS

BAND, CHOIR, ORCHESTRA: IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION

- Large group practice sessions, sectionals and rehearsals will adhere to social distancing guidelines provided by CISD, TEA, UIL and Montgomery County Health officials.
- Fine Arts music private lesson teachers will not be allowed to teach on campus facilities until further guidance is provided. Private lessons may continue to be conducted virtually, if agreed upon between individual families and the lesson teacher. All district guidelines will continue to be followed.
- Off-campus fine arts performances will only be conducted if specific guidance is provided by an authorized entity (CISD, TEA, UIL, etc.)
- Concerts/performance may be adjusted based upon health and safety guidelines provided by an authorized entity (CISD, TEA, UIL, etc.) including, but not limited to: transportation procedures, number of attendees and the orientation of concerts.
- All fine arts performances will be streamed online when possible.
- Booster club meetings should be held virtually, to minimize outside exposure to campus.
- Distancing guidelines will be followed within classrooms.
- Supplies will not be shared between students.
- If classroom sets of supplies or equipment must be used, sterilization and sanitation guidelines must be followed.
- Supply lists and/or fee requirements will be provided to students. In most cases, these supplies will be bulk ordered by campuses and distributed directly to students.
- In anticipation of intermittent closure, classroom instructional supplies must be taken home every day, and not left in classrooms.
- In anticipation of intermittent closure, students must have access to the online course platform as well as means to document progress on current assignments or projects. (e.g. Camera phone, digital camera, etc.). Individual student needs may be able to be accommodated through a student's home campus.
- Explicit classroom procedures will be utilized during supply distribution, cleanup, and other activities.
- Sufficient time will be allotted in each class period to accommodate for these explicit classroom procedures.
- Uniforms and all accompanying pieces will be issued to each individual student.
- Students will come to concerts fully dressed in designated concert uniforms and no changing areas will be provided.
- In specific instances, students may need to come to the campus at designated times to attend class periods or concerts (e.g., required rehearsals) .

BAND, CHOIR, ORCHESTRA: REMOTE/ONLINE INSTRUCTION

- Regular and frequent interaction between students and teachers will be expected.
- Course expectations for remote learning will be of equal rigor to face-to face instruction.
- Students will be provided with rubrics and procedures for completion of assignments.

- Students may be required to log-in at designated times and for designated amounts of time to complete each course's requirements.
- Assignment due dates will be comparable to Traditional In-Person course requirements.
- Supply lists and/or fee requirements will be provided to students. In most cases, these supplies will be bulk ordered by campuses and distributed directly to students.
- Students must have access to the online course platform as well as means to document progress on current assignments or projects. (e.g. camera phone, digital camera, etc.). Individual student needs may be able to be accommodated through a student's home campus.
- In specific instances, students may need to come to the campus at designated times to attend class periods or concerts (e.g., required rehearsals)
- In specific instances, students may need to come to the campus at designated times to acquire required instructional materials.

VISUAL ARTS: IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION

- No group projects (i.e. murals) will be done.
- Distancing guidelines will be followed within classrooms.
- Supplies will not be shared between students.
- If classroom sets of supplies must be used, sterilization and sanitation guidelines must be followed.
- Students will only handle their own artwork.
- Supply lists and/or fee requirements will be provided to students. In most cases, these supplies will be bulk ordered by campuses and distributed directly to students.
- In anticipation of intermittent closure, supplies and artwork or sketchbooks must be taken home every day, and not left in classrooms.
- Explicit classroom procedures will be utilized during supply distribution, cleanup, artwork turn-in, and other activities.
- Sufficient time will be allotted in each class period to accommodate for these explicit classroom procedures.

VISUAL ARTS: REMOTE/ONLINE INSTRUCTION

- Regular and frequent interaction between students and teachers will be expected.
- Students will be provided with rubrics and procedures for completion of assignments.
- Supply lists and/or fee requirements will be provided to students. In most cases, these supplies will be bulk ordered by campuses and distributed directly to students.
- Students must have access to the online course platform as well as means to document progress on current art projects. (ie. camera phone, digital camera, etc.)
- In specific instances, students may need to attend class periods and/or bring artwork (ie. ceramics projects or other specialized media) to the campus at designated times.
