Sessions

- **On August 4, 2022 teachers and administrators are to attend the District Wide Professional Learning at the various campus locations.** All teachers must be seated by 8:00 a.m. for the first session. Teachers need to schedule time to sign-in **prior to the 8:00 a.m. start time.** A scanning process with a timestamp will be in place to note participation. The Teaching and Learning Department will enroll entire campus groups into Eduphoria Conference for attendance purposes (see ticket/barcode section).
- Teachers will attend general sessions and/or mini-sessions. These mini-sessions will include a major focus on assessment and students achieving at higher levels as well as all components of the Conroe ISD Instructional Model with an emphasis on integration of online assessment items and instructional practices, Common Formative Assessments (CFAs), accommodations and their use in daily instruction, Marzano’s 43 Elements, Curriculum Management Design and Alignment feedback, and best practices on Classroom Environment.
- Many of the mini-sessions are teacher choice and will be organized in a conference style format.

 - Teachers may pull up their subject area attachment to review the District Wide Professional Learning information. Teachers are advised to read the entire attachment.
- Many of the mini-sessions have limited participation. When a session reaches the maximum number of participants, the session will be closed. Limiting the number of participants for a session addresses the issues of space and the number of handouts needed. As in any conference format, once a session is closed the teacher will attend his or her second or third choice. Teachers will receive hard copies of the session schedule and room assignments upon arrival. Session titles will be posted on the doors.
- At each location, teachers will have their barcodes scanned in the morning as they arrive and in the afternoon as they leave. The scanners will date and time stamp each barcode. (Review barcode information.)
- No food or drinks should be brought into the sessions.

Required Elementary and Intermediate Assignments of Science and Social Studies

Due to the focus on alignment of our Science and Social Studies subject areas across grade levels, each elementary principal is to send at least one teacher at each grade level 3rd through 6th to attend the Science and Social Studies District Wide Professional Learning. Intermediate campuses are to have representation in Social Studies and Science as well.

Barcode

Teachers will use their barcodes located on the back of their campus IDs for District Wide Professional Learning. The barcode will serve as an **admission ticket**.

At each location, teachers will have their barcodes scanned in the morning as they arrive and in the afternoon as they leave. The scanners will date and time stamp each barcode ticket.

If a teacher does not have his/her barcode, he/she must sign in and sign out.

Time and Parking

We are requesting that **all teachers arrive and are seated by 8:00 a.m. for their first session. We encourage teachers to have carpools designated prior to the professional learning day.** CISD police will be requested to direct traffic at the larger attendance locations at opening and closing of the sessions to expedite traffic flow.

Certificates of Attendance

Teachers will be able to print their certificate of attendance by September 14th via Eduphoria Conference.
