Introduction – Dr. Curtis Null, *Superintendent*

- Looking for a package this committee will support, the Board will support, and the voters will support
- Options in the handouts are not defined packages – they are just a starting point for your conversation
- Size of the Grand Oaks 7-8,9 has grown; increased size of building to hold more students which added \$14 million to project
- Infrastructure - \$222 million is the baseline number
- Land - \$36 million is the baseline number

Survey Questions

Round 1

- How many schools should be included?
 - 10 – 9%, 9 – 38%, 8 – 44%, 7 – 0%, 6 or fewer – 9%
- Should playgrounds and gyms be a separate proposition?
 - Yes – 73%
- Should TWHS renovation be included?
 - Yes – 89%
- Should McCullough addition be included in the proposition?
 - Yes – 94%
- Should ORHS Phase II be included in the proposition?
 - Yes – 90%

Round 2

- Should 8 or 9 Schools (or other) be included?
 - 9 – 52%, 8 – 45%, Other – 3%
- Should playgrounds be in a separate proposition?
 - Yes – 89%
- Should gyms be in a separate proposition?
 - Yes – 51%, No – 49%
- Should ORHS Phase III be included?
 - Yes – 62%, No – 38%
- How much should be included for Infrastructure?
 - \$300M - 12%, \$260M - 43%, \$222M - 40%, Other - 5%
- How much should be included for land?
 - \$36M – 11%, \$50M – 57%, \$75M – 23%, Other – 9%

- How much should be included for Transportation/Buses?
 - \$10M – 9%, \$12M – 57%, \$16M – 33%, Other – 1%
- How much should be included for Transportation/Centers?
 - \$10M – 56%, \$17.5M – 25%, \$25M – 14%, Other – 5%

Round 3

- Should at least eight (8) schools be included?
 - Yes – 83%
- Should at least \$222 million be included for infrastructure?
 - Yes – 91%
- Should at least \$50 million be included for land?
 - Yes – 71%
- Should at least \$12 million be included for buses?
 - Yes – 94%
- Should at least \$10 million be included for transportation centers?
 - Yes – 95%

Closing – Dr. Curtis Null, *Superintendent*

- We know we will have 2 Props – Proposition A and another proposition for technology devices. We will hear more at the next meeting on CTE and athletics. We should have no more than five propositions and five is probably a lot.
- Most districts will pass A & B, but after that, support usually falls off.

Questions

- When we decide on gyms, do we also decide where they go?

You will first decide on the number, then that is a discussion we will need to have and see which gyms are included in other renovation projects.
- When deciding on phases for Oak Ridge, do we have to pick the number for Phase II or Phase III, or can we come up with a number between that?

We would prefer that number to be one or the other. There are aspects of the projects that cannot be moved between the two phases.
- Can gyms and playgrounds be put in a separate proposition with athletics?

No, by state legislation, athletics has to stand alone.
