#### **Safety Implications**

Too many swimmers crowded into same lane causes collisions and injuries

Overcrowded lanes create slow moving workouts and does not allow for proper training to take place.

#### **Currently**

9-10 swimmers per lane

Ideal -4 or less swimmers


Manageable -5-6 swimmers

Excessive -7 or more swimmers

We had developed a system in the dayto-day operations that allows for District teams, community, and area club teams to all use the facility. However, now with the added growth of the District, that is no longer the case.







# **Need for Water Space**

We are now faced with the need to rent outside pool space for our programs or to start cutting participation from our students that desire to be in these programs.

There is simply not enough room for our teams to practice in the Natatorium.

- Swim practice is twice per day
- Junior Varsity practices in the morning, Varsity in the afternoon
- The practices are bookended in the school day to allow for transportation time from school to the facility, and back.
- Many of the swimmers also come back after school to swim/practice with their Club team.



#### Benefits



#### **Benefits of an Outdoor Pool**

- 8-lane/50-meter pool
- Adequate practice space for high school teams
- Can be converted to 20 short course/25-yard lanes
- Allows all 6 high school teams the opportunity to practice at the same time
- Allows all teams to practice water polo without interfering with swim practice space

#### **NATURAL GRASS**

650-800 hours of play per year with rest between heavy play and inclement weather

Requires mowing, watering, seeding, fertilizing, pesticides, and aeration which increases labor costs

Less opportunities for events due to the rest time required between play time or inclement weather

Preserves natural environment of the soil and vegetation while sequestering carbon and releasing oxygen, requirepesticides

Costs less for the initial installatio with slower ROI as a result of limited hours for usage and increased maintenance costs

Cannot withstand heavy use for multiple sports and events on one field

Use can be limited due to necessary rest time

#### **SYNTHETIC TURF**

Unlimited hours of play per year with no rest required

Requires cleaning and topping off infill levels periodically through the life cycle

Can be used 24/7/365 for sports, community events or other revenue generating activities

Promotes water conservation 440,000-1,000,000 gal. per year depending on climate and soil conditions and requries no pesticides

Pays for itself faster due to facility rentals and lower maintenance costs

Will allow for multiple sports and events on one field

Can achieve more use with the same amount of space
