





























Five Emergency Planning Components

- 4. Response
- 5. Recovery
- Our focus tonight is in things that fall in the Mitigation/Prevention Category
 - Things that can be Built or Constructed
 - What we can do before an incident.
- Texas Education Code 37.109 Establishes a District Level Safety Committee
- The BPC charge is to establish a value to allocate for a District-wide Initiative



- Texas Education Code 37.109 Requires School Districts to convene a committee to serve the school district to help create and maintain a a safe and secure school climate and culture for staff and students
 - Membership consists of (at a minimum)
 - The City or County Office of Emergency Management
 - Local Police Department or Sheriff's office
 - School Board (The president and at least one additional trustee)
 - Superintendent of Schools
 - Classroom Teacher
 - At Least two parents of currently enrolled students
 - District Police Department



- District Safety Committee
 - Responsibilities (included but not limited to)
 - Participate in the development of emergency plans (our buildings and systems play a role)
 - Provide recommendations to the board of trustees and administration on MEOPs and Best Practices to be implemented in district facilities



- Texas Education Code 61.1040(k) Safety & Security Standards
 - Required for Capital Improvements budgeted after November 1, 2021
 - Communications Infrastructure
 - MHEOP
 - Communications Infrastructure
 - Site plans and Floor Plans for each facility
 - Access Control
 - Exterior Door Numbering
 - Visitor Management
 - Unobstructed line of sight of approaching visitors (physical or digital)
 - Physical barrier that prevents unassisted access to the facility
 - Location for visitor check-in and check-out process
 - Security Cameras
 - TEA Rules and Guidelines are continually evolving
 - Conroe ISD seeks to exceed the minimum requirements



- Bond Planning Committee
 - Responsibilities
 - Recommend a Districtwide Bond Budget to be included in the Bond Package
 - 2019 Bond Committee Recommended \$5 million per year (\$25 million 2020-2024)
 - At the completion of the 2019 Bond Projects every campus in the district received work
 - Work included
 - Access Control
 - Door Monitoring Alarms
 - Fire Alarm System Upgrades
 - Exterior Lighting
 - Fencing
 - Security Cameras and Servers
 - Generator Upgrades
 - First Responder Antenna Systems
 - District Radio Antenna Systems
 - Shatter Resistant Film at Secure Vestibules
