- Students enrolled in Algebra I are expected to take the end-of-course exams during the testing window of December 2024.
- . All payments must be paid in full by May 31, 2024. Course credit will not be awarded if payment has not been received in full.

- Step 2: The school counselor will provide the student a flyer with detailed instructions on how to proceed with payment.

Course credit will not be awarded if payment has not been received in full.

VIRTUAL LEARNING STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

It is important that students and parents understand the expectations for taking an accelerated course through the virtual learning model. Each student interested in taking a course needs to read the expectations listed below prior to registering for the course.

- 1. Students must have access to and fluency with a computer and the CISD Outlook email system.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the student/parent to maintain their computer and/or software. If the student does not have access at home to a computer and/or to the Internet, the student needs to make his/her counselor aware when registering for the course. CISD will provide assistance.
- Students are expected to commit to full participation in the virtual course including regular attendance and completion of assigned coursework.
- 4. Students are responsible for completing and submitting all assignments by the established due date.
- 5. All work performed and submitted will be the student's own work. Students providing lesson assignments, tests, and exams determined not to be their own work will be subject to disciplinary actions as detailed in the CISD Secondary Student Handbook.

- Time spent on coursework will be monitored. Students are expected to spend time every day on their virtual course in order to keep up with assignments in addition to fulfilling their regular classroom responsibilities.
- Students agree to check their CISD email account on a regular basis during the week and weekends for communications regarding their virtual course.
- 8. Inappropriate online communications or inappropriate use of online tools may lead to disciplinary action.
- Students enrolled in virtual courses are subject to the CISD discipline policies and procedures as detailed in the CISD Secondary Student Handbook.
- 10. Students enrolled in Algebra I will be required to take the end-of-course (EOC) exam in December 2024.
- 11. Students are expected to maintain a minimum grade of 80 to remain in the course.

COURSE OFFERINGS/CONTENT

• The summer school program shall meet the same standards as those in effect during the regular school year. Students have the opportunity to earn one credit. First semester classes will be offered during Session 1 and second semester classes during Session 2. Students who need to take a full credit of an academic course need to enroll in both Sessions 1 and 2. The summer school for credit program is targeted to students who have previously taken a course and have not been successful. Initial credit opportunities are also available.

The summer school for credit program is targeted to students who have previously taken a course and have not been successful.

Conroe ISD Secondary Academic Programs Summer School Rules and Guidelines

All summer school course grades, including failing grades, will appear on the student's official transcript and will affect his/her GPA. Any course attempted and dropped after the first week has elapsed will result in a grade of "WF" (Withdrew Failing), which will appear on the student's official transcript and will affect GPA.

Campus and CISD Code of Conduct rules will apply. Students will be given specific rules on the first day of class. A closed campus will be observed during summer school.

A minimum of 15 students must enroll in a course in order for the course to be held.

Attendance: Regular attendance is of great importance. Students will be held responsible for all work missed due to an absence without any undue amount of work on the part of the instructor.

- Only ½ day of absence per session is allowed in summer school regardless of the number of sessions/courses taken.
- Students leaving school 15 minutes or more before school is dismissed will receive an equivalent of a tardy. Four tardies result in one absence.
- Tardies: A tardy is from 0-15 minutes late to class. Four tardies will result in one absence. A ½ day absence results if a student is more than 15 minutes late to class or school. A full-day absence will be recorded for any student failing to attend class after any break.
- Semester exams are administered the last day of each session. There are no test exemptions
 in summer school. Students must be present the last day of each session to receive credit in
 the course.

If a student withdraws after the second day of summer school, tuition will not be refunded. If students are dropped for disciplinary reasons, they will forfeit their tuition.

Students who choose to eat at school will need to bring a lunch. Limited snacks and drinks will be available for sale by booster organizations in the cafeteria area during break time.
