

If your student has a documented disability, they may be eligible for accommodations when they take the ACT.

START EARLY

All requests for accommodations, including appeals, must be submitted by the published late registration deadline for your student's preferred test date through the Test Accessibility and Accommodations system.

APPROVAL IS REQUIRED

Students and families will need to work with a school official when making a request to ACT.

REGISTER FOR TEST

Students and families will create an account or sign in and register for the test with accommodations.

Online registration will ask for accessibility needs.

SEND EMAIL & CONSENT TO RELEASE FORM TO SCHOOL

ACT will send an email that you must forward to your student's school official along with a completed Consent to Release Information form signed by parent.

If the student is over age 18, the student signs the form.

SCHOOL SUBMITS

The student's school official will submit the request, with documentation, to ACT.

ACT DECISION

ACT will review the request and email a Decision Notification to your student's school. The school official will contact the student and family once they receive the decision notification. Requests are normally processed in 10 to 14 days.
