Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS)

Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) is the foundation for all that we do in Conroe ISD. PBIS is a positive, proactive, and instructional approach to strengthen school climate, improve classroom management, promote positive relationships in schools, and provide students with social and behavioral skills needed to be successful learners. In Conroe ISD, we have adopted the CHAMPS approach to PBIS from Safe and Civil Schools. This is a process of thinking about classroom and behavior management that guides teachers in making research and data-based decisions on classroom management to add tools into each teacher's toolbox. It is based on the beliefs that teachers should structure their classrooms for success, explicitly teach rules, expectations and procedures, observe student behavior, interact positively, and correct fluently. Adopting the CHAMPS approach allows us to share best practices and common language across the district with staff and students alike.

During Intro to CISD, all teachers will have the opportunity to participate in learning that will be applicable to their own classroom.

Wednesday, July 26, 2023: Novice Teachers will develop an understanding of the why behind PBIS and work with the Student Support Services team to build an understanding of the essential components of classroom management. Teachers will walk away prepared for Day 1 of school with a classroom management plan and clear understanding of the structures, procedures, and routines necessary to set students up for a successful school year.

Thursday, July 27, 2023: Experienced Elementary Teachers (grades PK-6) who are new to Conroe ISD will receive a three-hour overview of PBIS in CISD. Teachers will develop a shared understanding of our district's PBIS model, best practices for classroom management, and a common language we all share surrounding PBIS. They will collaborate with the Student Support Services team, reflect on their current practices and spend time solidifying their classroom management plan for the upcoming school year.

Friday, July 28, 2023: Experienced Secondary Teachers (grades 7-12) who are new to Conroe ISD will receive a three-hour overview of PBIS in CISD. Teachers will develop a shared understanding of our district's PBIS model, best practices for classroom management, and a common language we all share surrounding PBIS. They will collaborate with the Student Support Services team, reflect on their current practices and spend time solidifying their classroom management plan for the upcoming school year.
