A regular meeting of the Conroe Independent School District Board of Trustees was held Tuesday, March 19, 2024, in the Board Room of the Deane L. Sadler Administration Building located at 3205 W. Davis, Conroe, TX 77304. Board President Skeeter Hubert called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. Mr. Williams led the invocation and Mrs. Dungan led the pledges.
