- 3-year contract total \$1.24M-\$1.7M

Staying Safe: School Safety Response Training

- A new curriculum developed in partnership with Safe and Sound Schools and Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training (ALERRT) that teaches students and staff their very own age and ability options to school safety during an active event
- Based upon Safe and Sound Schools' curriculum and ALERRT's Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events (CRASE), this curriculum will be offered as a six-hour train-thetrainer session for all regional Education Service Centers (ESC)





Staying Safe: School Safety Response Training

- There was some good information from the training that we can incorporate into what we currently offer
- The 'main purpose' is to address students and empower them
 - Want students to think critically
 - A lot of information about it being a personal choice of the student
 - Wanted small group discussion in class on level of response to an incident
- Would need commitment from all staff
- Did not include the 5 phases of emergency management
 - No Prevention



Staying Safe: School Safety Response Training

- Run/Avoid
- Hide/Deny
- Fight/Disrupt
- Would be a language change and deviation from the SRP (Standard Response Protocol)
- The introduction of Disrupt would be at Intermediate/JH
- The training led us to believe that Deny/Disrupt were the same
 - The presenter(s) would interchange the use of Deny/Disrupt/Defend
