A regular meeting of the Conroe Independent School District Board of Trustees was held Tuesday, May 14, 2024, in the Board Room of the Deane L. Sadler Administration Building located at 3205 W. Davis, Conroe, TX 77304. Teaching & Learning

The Board of Trustees approved the purchase of the Proclamation 2024 materials recommended by the District's Instructional Materials Committee. The Board discussed and approved all recommended materials except for 3 omissions in Savvas science materials to comply with the State Board of Education's recommendations in Proclamation 2024.

The Board adopted CATCH Global Foundation's Health Ed Journeys Curriculum as a resource to provide instruction regarding fentanyl and drug abuse prevention to students in grades 6-8.

Assistant Superintendent for Elementary Education Dr. Shellie Winkler provided information and answered questions from board members regarding standards based report cards for second grade.

Planning and Construction

The Board of Trustees approved the following and authorized the Superintendent to negotiate and execute the contract documents for each:

- Nash Industries, Inc. as the construction manager-at-risk for the Natatorium Renovations Project
- The guaranteed maximum price amendment for the New 7th-8th, 9th Grade Campus Project to benefit the Grand Oaks Feeder

The Board of Trustees received the progress and status of current capital improvement projects.

Business/Purchasing

The Board approved to award RFP #24-03-02 Copier Equipment Rental or Lease to Marimon, Inc. and authorized the Superintendent to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the purchase.

Business/Finance

Director of Finance Karen Garza presented the financial report.

Legal

The Board received information to consider regarding revisions to Board Policy EIE *Academic Achievement – Retention and Promotion*. To implement standards based report cards in second grade across the District, Board Policy EIE must be modified to reflect the change.

In a 4-3 vote the Board of Trustees approved to adopt bylaws for the School Health Advisory Council as presented.

The Board of Trustees discussed but took no action on establishing FA Local Policy Student Welfare: Parental Authority and Gender Fluidity Matters.

At the request of Trustee Dungan and Trustee Nelson, President Hubert removed agenda items XI-D and XI-E. The items will be added to the June 18, 2024, Regular Board Meeting Agenda.
